Basic Shag Tips

Style Tips

The loose hand is held at the hip, elbow slightly bent, as if the hand were holding a beer. Shag is also a compact dance whereby the couple stays in a small area dancing "north to south" and taking small steps (A rule of thumb: in the basic the heel of the stepping foot should not go further than the toe of the stationary foot, or vice-versa on a backward step). The steps are more of a shuffle than an actual step and you may find it easier to obtain this look by sliding your feet along the floor instead of actually stepping. Unlike Jitterbug or Swing, there is no "side to side" or "bobbing" motion in shag. Instead you should move forward and back with the appearance of gliding.

- 2. Don't take large steps.
- Don't move the contact hand up & down or side to side.
 This could be confusing to the lady and will look like crap.
- 4. Don't over imbibe.


