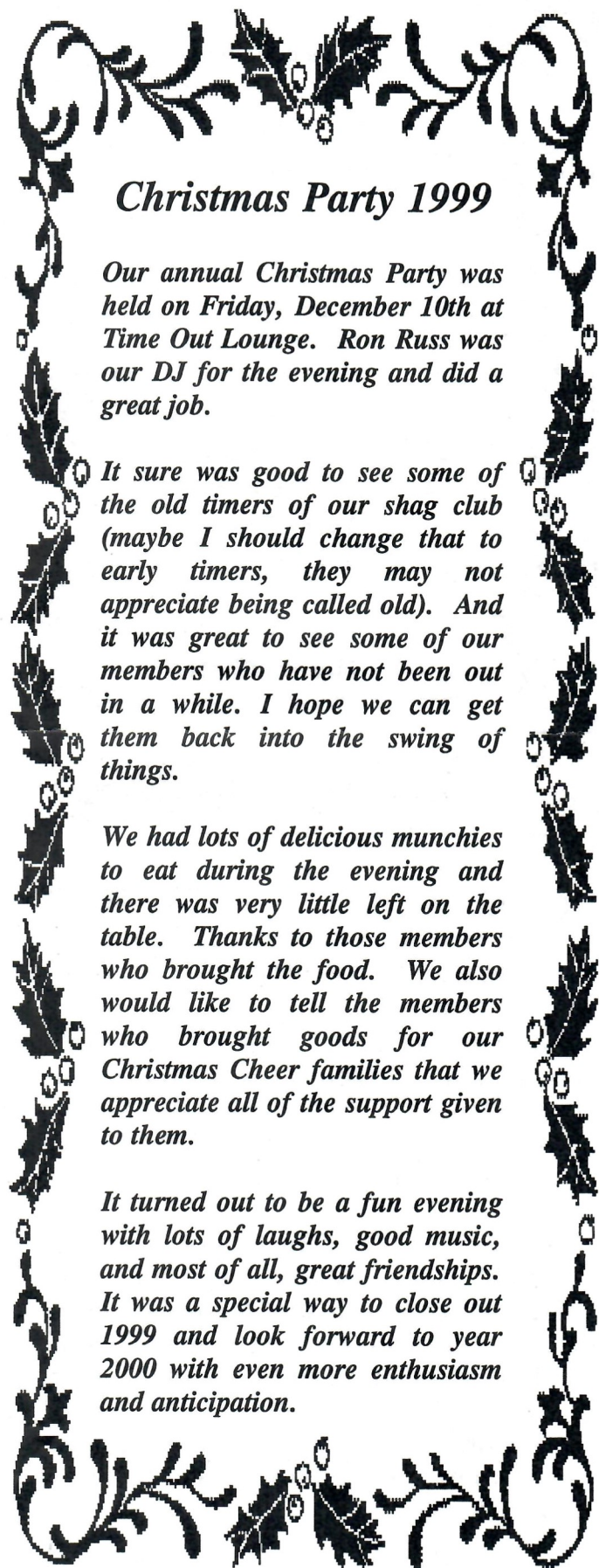
Christmas Party 1999

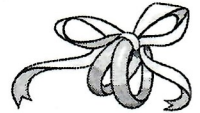

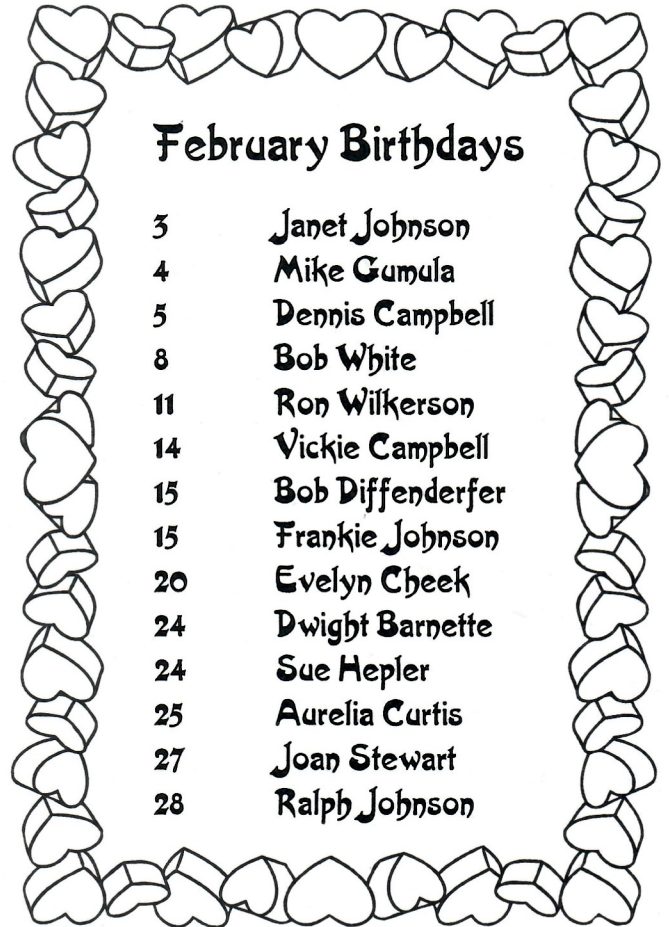

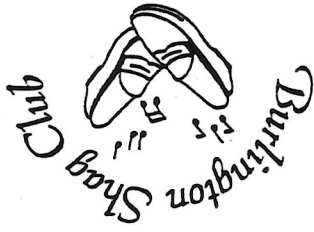
