Minutes of the BSC Meeting held 03-21-03

- Ronnie opened the meeting, welcoming all members and encouraging participation.
- Secretary' Report: (Vice President Brenda Smith stood in for Peg Hansen in her absence)
- Current Membership is 215, minutes from the last meeting were read.
- Treasurer's Report: Balance as of March 21, 2003 is \$7,726.03.
- Kent Bradsher-reported all members who had not renewed their membership have been contacted and advised of their expired membership.
- Steve Mahone-Announced Committee members for Fun Golf: Chuck Upchurch, Pam Mahone, and Bob Macia. All arrangements have been made for the tournament, food, etc. Flyers were handed out.
- Ronnie reported on the recent ACSC meeting held in Greenville, SC. It was encouraging to attend and find out what the ACSC is doing for the community as well as the "Shag". All meetings are open for anyone to attend.
- After discussion, Dave Oakley made the motion to continue sponsoring the Meals on Wheels event with our involvement in the year 2004. Unanimously, the motion carried.
- It was reported that the Holiday Band has made an offer of playing at the event under a 3-year contract of \$1500/year. Motion was made by Nita Wilson to retain the Holiday Band for the Meals on Wheels event for the next 3 years for \$1500/year. Motion was 2nd and vote was taken. Motion carried. It was also voted on to have the Jr Shaggers for the MOW event. Ronnie announced that he would appoint a Special Board to oversee the organization of the Meals on Wheels event. This Board will consist of the BSC Officers and long time involved members. This special Board will help to smooth out the details and act as a liaison with Meals on Wheels officials.
- The proposed Burlington Shag Club Hall of Fame amendment to the By-Laws will be published in the April Newsletter. All members are encouraged to read the proposal and be ready to discuss and/or vote on this issue.
- Club T-Shirts were discussed at length. Chuck Upchurch has made a contact with "Sports Specialty" in Hillsboro and presented shirt samples for quality. Choice of 3 colors, 50 order minimum, cost with embroidery \$19.95. There will be a 1 time set up charge. Judy Hunt was unsuccessful in locating "Outer banks" at the beach. She will continue to try to locate. Reported very good quality, and many colors to choose from. Already has logo on hand. No set up or minimum order requirements. Denise Upchurch reported "IVARS" in Graham has a special on embroidered denim or golf shirts. Not sure about set-up fee. Will make some additional contacts. Mary Gregory reported that Angela's Embroidery in Downtown Burlington has our logo on-hand. There is no minimum amount; can take your own shirt to have BSC logo embroidered. It was also mentioned that "L and B" was the company that provided shirts last year. Issue was tabled due to more information needed.
- Brenda Smith asked the club members present to consider getting involved in SOS by having a float in the "Spring Safari" Parade to be held on Saturday, May 3. Cost of float is \$400, which includes the Burlington Shag Club in Block letters on each side of float. Mike Hayes made the motion that the BSC have a float with a cap of \$400 spending out of the club treasury for the event. Motion was 2nd and vote taken. Motion carried. Ronnie asked Brenda Smith to form a committee to plan the event.
- Linda Macia asked the Club to help the family we have helped for 4 years at Christmas during the Easter holiday by donating \$200 for Easter Baskets for the children as well as a Ham for the family. Denise Upchurch made the motion for the club to donate \$200 for Easter Cheer for this family. Motion was 2nd and vote taken. Motion carried.
- Newsletter Editors Clint and Angie Sharpe announced deadline for April Newsletter to be March 24. Also that they will begin emailing the Newsletter to all members in which they have an email address. In addition, a hard copy will be sent this month. Anyone who does not wish to get the Newsletter via email must let them know before the next month's issue is released.

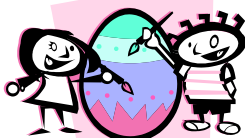
6. Hall of Fame Committee



- a) Shall consist of 5 volunteers from current BSC members and it's officers.
- b) Shall elect a chairperson and/or co-chairperson from the 5 volunteers.
- c) Will receive properly endorsed nominations (on the club's nomination form) by October 1st. Mail completed form directly to the chairperson.
- d) Shall review, screen, and verify the forms to ensure eligibility and criteria have been met by October 15th. Confidentiality will remain within the committee. No more that two (2) persons shall be selected for induction in any given year.
- e) Will meet by October 31st with the BSC officers for the sole purpose of voting. Chairperson will copy nomination form(s) to each officer prior to the meeting. Voting shall be by secret ballot and nominees must receive a majority vote to be inducted annually according to the following criteria:
 - 1. Must hold current BSC membership.
 - 2. Must be 50 years old or older.
 - 3. Must have distinguished themselves in the "Shag World" for a minimum of three (3) years in ONE OR MORE of the following categories:
 - a. Distinguished service for the BSC and/or the ACSC/SOS.
 - b. Distinguished service as an officer and/or committee chairperson of the BSC and/or the ACSC/SOS.
 - c. Regular attendance and participation in the BSC club and/or ACSC/SOS events.
 - d. Distinguished service as a (shag) teacher and/or competitor in local, area, or national shag competitions.
- f) Will have Chairperson announce new inductees at the November business meeting.
- g) Shall make inductees life-time members of the club.
- h) Will recognize the new inductees by their name(s) being added to the club's Hall of Fame plaque
- i) Shall honor the new inductees by a spotlight break dance with any and all BSC members at the Christmas Party.

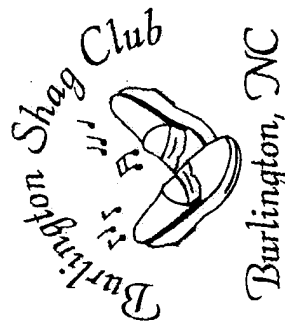
