PROPOSED CHANGES TO BY LAWS

V. Meetings

Current:

C. Special meetings called by the President or by written request of at least eight (8) members will require three (3) days notice, except in case of an emergency.

Proposed:

C. Special meetings called by:

(1) the President, or in his/her absence

(2) the chain of Command or by

(3) written request of eight (8) members

Special meetings will require at least three (3) days advance notice.

The telephone committee will notify each club member within 24 hours prior to the called meeting.

VI. Quorum

Current:

A quorum is present when eight (8) or more members are in attendance.

Proposed:

VI. Voting

- A. A properly deemed voting body would constitute a minimum of ten percent (10%) of the total club membership at a meeting.
 With January and February being considered membership enrollment months, issues brought forth during these months will use the membership as stated as of December 31.
- B. For issues on the floor, the vote will be decided by a majority of the members present.
- C. In respect to the nomination of officers, newly elected officers shall have received a majority of the votes cast for each office.

- 6. Hall of Fame Committee
 - a) Shall consist of 5 volunteers from current BSC members and it's officers.
 - b) Shall elect a chairperson and/or co-chairperson from the 5 volunteers.
 - c) Will receive properly endorsed nominations (on the club's nomination form) by October 1st. Mail completed form directly to the chairperson.
 - d) Shall review, screen, and verify the forms to ensure eligibility and criteria have been met by October 15th. <u>Confidentiality</u> will remain within the committee. No more that two (2) persons shall be selected for induction in any given year.
 - e) Will meet by October 31st with the BSC officers for the sole purpose of voting. Chairperson will copy nomination form(s) to each officer prior to the meeting. Voting shall be by secret ballot and nominees must receive a majority vote to be inducted annually according to the following criteria:
 - 1. Must hold current BSC membership.
 - 2. Must be 50 years old or older.
 - 3. Must have distinguished themselves in the "Shag World" for a minimum of three (3) years in ONE OR MORE of the following categories:
 - a. Distinguished service for the BSC and/or the ACSC/SOS.
 - b. Distinguished service as an officer and/or committee chairperson of the BSC and/or the ACSC/SOS.
 - c. Regular attendance and participation in the BSC club and/or ACSC/SOS events.
 - d. Distinguished service as a (shag) teacher and/or competitor in local, area, or national shag competitions.
 - f) Will have Chairperson announce new inductees at the November business meeting.
 - g) Shall make inductees life-time members of the club.
 - h) Will recognize the new inductees by their name(s) being added to the club's Hall of Fame plaque
 - i) Shall honor the new inductees by a spotlight break dance with any and all BSC members at the Christmas Party.


