- Treasurer's report: Balance as of Oct 17, \$8,159.39
- At a special meeting on Oct. 10, the club decided to move to the Best Western effective Oct. 31.
- Nominations of Officers took place and Bob Maccia will call each individual officer to see if they wish to run for office. Decisions must be made and Bob Maccia notified by 10/24/03.
- A motion to have all the candidates make a presentation before the election was defeated.
- Elections will take place at the Nov. meeting
- Congratulations to Al Fogleman and Steve McHone the newest members of the Hall of Fame. Induction will take place at the Christmas Party.
- The Christmas Party will be held at the Ramada Inn on Dec 13th. A \$200 deposit was given to the hotel. In place of the lawn buddy; raffle tickets will be sold for a cash prizes in the amounts of \$1,000; \$300 and \$100. Winners do not have to be present. The entry fee for the Christmas Party will be \$5.
- The Special Olympics golf tournament raised over \$9,000. Congratulations to Steve and everyone else who worked so hard including Jess Justice, Al Fogleman, Gail Jordan, Evelyn Turner, Linda Justice and the "Refreshment Cart Girls". The Shag Club received another plaque from Special Olympics. Thank you, Baxter for the refreshment donation.
- Kent Bradsher requested money for the planning of the re-up party. Club asked for the cost to be researched before determining if funds would be available and at what amount.
- The motion to have the membership fee at \$10 if an SOS ticket was purchased at the same time before Dec. 31 was denied. The membership fee will be remain at \$15.
- The cut off date for SOS tickets will be Feb. 15<sup>th</sup>, 2004. The tickets are \$30 and you must be a 2004 paid member to purchase an SOS ticket.
- The club will donate \$100 for the purchase of Thanksgiving Day dinner for our Christmas Cheer family.
- Postcards will be sent out to all members with the Nov date for the Meals On Wheels meeting. Members wishing to help with this function are requested to attend.
- The Festival of the Oaks was a great success. Approximately 30 Burlington Shag Club members came out to dance.
- The Halloween Party will be held at the Best Western. Laura Walker of the Best Western has donated \$500 for food at the party. \$50 prizes will be given for the best male and best female costumes.
- The membership committee will report back on the cost and date of the re-up party.
- A motion to donate money to Christmas Cheer, Special Olympics and Meals on Wheels was tabled till the Nov. meeting.
- The appointing of a by-laws committee has been tabled till Nov. Sheila Walker has been named as chairperson. It was noted that she did not volunteer and that according to the bylaws, the President can appoint the chairperson.
- The discussion of a Sergeant at Arms will be taken up the by-laws committee.
- The club, which is a non-profit club, may have up to \$10,000 in the treasury.


