BURLINGTON SHAG CLUB

Founded in August 1985 History Article by Dianne Fogleman

In the 1980's, local shaggers were going to the Best Western on Huffman Mill Road on Thursday and Saturday nights for dancing. Music was provided by Bob Bullard, D. J. In 1985, I approached Bob about starting up a shag club. We met with the Kourys, owners of Best Western, and presented our ideas. We were given permission to let Best Western be the home base of the shag club.

To help set rules and guidelines and plan activities, we asked several people to be on the Board of Directors. The first Board of Directors were: Lock McKinnon, Eddie Canada, Joan Kimbro, Cookie Fogleman, Judy Johnson, Lee Harless, Johnny Michaels, Candy Brooks, Randy Sandifer, Bill Inge, Bob Bullard and Dianne Fogleman. Spouses and! or significant others of board members also played big parts in starting the club. As members of this board moved away or resigned, they were replaced by other Shag Club members. The first board meeting was held Saturday, August 24, 1985, and the following officers were elected: Dianne Fogleman, President; Lock McKinnon, Vice President; Joan Kimbro, Secretary; and Bill Inge, Treasurer.

The Board of Directors chose Burlington <u>Triad</u> Shag Club as the name of the new club rather than Burlington Shag Club in hopes of drawing members from the entire Triad area. By the end of August, we had 100 members and 39 sponsors, and by the end of our second year, we had 250 members and around 50 sponsors -- sponsors in the local area, Greensboro and several from North Myrtle Beach.

Our first function was a Weejun Contest -- shortest, biggest, shiniest, sexiest and even ugliest shoes -- whereas we awarded ribbons plus a \$50 gift certificate from Bass Shoe Outlet.

Our next functions included a Farewell to Summer Party, SOS Training Party, dances classes, line dance classes, Turkey Party, golf tournaments and taking part in the Burlington, Graham and Gibsonville Christmas parades and Christmas Cheer. One special event started around 3 o'clock on a Saturday afternoon with lots of hors d'oeuvres, Beach Music Pursuit <u>AND</u> Delbert McClinton, his girlfriend and band. They were to perform that Saturday night at the Ramada Inn, and I called Delbert a month or so ahead of time to see if they would come over that afternoon to be with our club. It was a wonderful afternoon, and even though Delbert and his group had to leave around 6 p.m., the Shag Club continued partying at Best Western. One of the best events we ever had!!

A few years later, Best Western changed its format to Top 40, and the Shag Club moved to Carl's, then to Churchill's, Fat Richard's and Old Fogies. I stepped down as president after the first two years, and Joan Kimbro became president.


