#### BUSINESS MEETING MINUTES MARCH 19, 2004

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Balance as of March 19, 2004 \$11,515.42

**SECRETARY'S REPORT:** Current Membership: 331

- Ask Jesse Justice how the bowling game was coming along; he is still working on it.

- Ronnie Gregory brought meeting to order, and asked that everyone that had not picked up a ballot to go ahead and complete.
- Welcomed all members as well as new members.
- \*There was a special meeting called on March 10, 2004, in regards to where the shag club would move to. The floor was opened for discussion and if there were any questions that wanted to be asked before ballots were complete. Some of the questions addressed:
- 1. Would the dance floor be enlarged at Ramada: Yes a new floor would be put down as soon as Laura is back from her surgery.
- 2. Holiday Inn is to small, they have a ballroom but could not guarantee us anything, so that is out.
- 3. Zane stated that 333"s would pay the DJ's, at this time we pay \$400.00 a month, and \$4800 a year, that the shag club would not have to pay. Ronnie stated that what happens there is if we allow someone else to pay for Dj's that would mean would be mean at the mercy of them, taking away from the shag club on what they want to do and who they want to hear.
- Johnny had made the statement that he was going to play who he wanted, so the main concern is not having control of the DJ's and Shag club could have our DJ's on special events.
- 4.It was stated about moving the shag in the first place, and the reason for that was the growth of the shag club.
- 5. George Lewis made the comment that we have an outside, and inside place to dance at 333's and it would be more like a beach music place.
- 6. Ron Wilkerson asked what guarantee's do we have at 333's? We have no guarantees.
- 7. Ronnie stated that people are concerned about what we would lose if we left Best Western as well as Ramada, We are tied with the Koury's for the facilities that they let us use as far as Meals on Wheels, our meetings, Area Shag Club parties etc...at no cost. Then we would have to start looking for other places to hold all of our members and that would be an added cost.
- 8. Ronnie stated that the conversation with Johnny said that if he had a chance to book a band on Friday he would, where does that leave the shag club. Where does the shag club go then? Rick Turner concerned about Meals on Wheels and how we would have to pay for it.
- 9. We are very fortunate to have the facilities that the Koury's allow us to have at no cost.
- 10. We have to have a place for other people that come to support the Burlington Shag Club to stay at the hotel if needed, and they get the shag club rate.

- 11. Ronnie stated that everyone not get out of hand, this is your club and what you want that is why we are voting on this matter.
- 12. Vickie Lewis made an excellent comment, "This is not about what Johnny wants nor the Koury's it is the Shag Club" that makes that decision.
- 13. Zane stated that the shag club would get in half price when there is a band, by showing your membership card.
- \*\*Ronnie stated that everyone has heard what they need to hear to make there decision, let's move on with meeting.\*\*
- Sheila Walker, a discussion for DJ's not being booked when events were going on such as SOS. Tabled until next meeting.
- Bylaws: In the shag rag was a form to fill out what was wrong with bylaws and if there is anything they wanted to add she only received one form. The bylaws are available on Website, if you need a copy you may contact Mary Gregory she will get you one. If a form is not completed it will not be considered. Sheila will contact the members of the committee if she gets any more forms and they will discuss.
- Last month it was discussed about the plaque that was given to Harold Beaver's family, the cost was originally \$40.00 and the actual cost was \$122.65, Anne was getting it she had bought them a gift and felt like the shag club should pay the whole amount.

Motion was made and passed.

- Ronnie brought up about the trip made to Eden Shag Club, Everyone had a great time; there were 40 people on bus, 5 on another bus, plus approx. 15 that drove. It was a great trip and everyone enjoyed themselves very much and some of our members won prizes through out the night.
- Bus Trips: Denise Upchurch asked members if they would like to have a bus fund, at that time I let Brenda explain how it would work if voted on. 


