TREASURER'S REPORT: Balance as of April 16, 2004: \$9,039.94

The By-Laws state there is an annual report that is due and given be ready for the April meeting Mary's has copies if anyone would like to see or have one.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Current Membership: 334 Members

All members that have not renewed their membership will be removed this month to give the club an actual count by the next business meeting.

Ronnie Gregory brought meeting to order and welcomed all members as well as new members. Ronnie asked if everyone had a ballot for voting for Vice-President.

*Decision to make on Buddy Whaley resigning as Vice-President, Bob Maccia will take nominations from the floor for the position of VP. The nominees need to know they want to run and they will be asked if they would like to run once nominated. Steve McHone and Sheila Walker accepted to run for Vice-President. All members were asked to write in one name on ballot sheet and turn in.

- *Brenda Smith gave report on float committee. All participants have been meeting on Saturday's to complete the props, costumes, and to practice. 
