Minutes from Meeting held January 21, 2005:

Meeting was opened by Sheila Walker.

Current Membership: 308

- Angie Sharpe noted that the minutes from the November meeting were published in the December Shag Rag and asked the membership if any changes needed to be made. No changes were indicated, the minutes stand.
- Treasure's report was given by Mary Gregory; see Shag Rag for details.
- Sheila Walker introduced all committee chairpersons and asked them to stand before the
 membership. Carl Hansen wanted clarification as to who was supposed to appoint these
 chairpersons, the president or a committee. Sheila Walker confirmed that the bylaws
 state the president appoints all chairpersons.
- Mid-Winter was held the prior weekend; the meeting was very informative and the weather was very cold.
- Sheila mentioned that she had several flyers for other shag club's functions; if anyone
 interested they were welcome to look at them at the close of the meeting. Sheila also
 mentioned that the Cyclone II tickets were on sale and that there were not many left. In
 addition, she checked into the availability of the rooms and they are going fast.

Meals on Wheels-

MOW dancing at the Mall will be held February 11th, Roy Childress will be the DJ playing. Denise Upchurch needs six groups of two people to fill the slots to work the door for MOW. Please contact her if you are interested.

All tickets purchased in advance need to be paid for at the time of purchase; these prepurchased tickets will no longer be allowed to be paid for at the door the night of the event. However, the paid for tickets can be left at the front door for people to pick them up.

Tickets are allowed to be sold during the promotional "Shagging at the Mall" event, but members of the club cannot actively solicit people who are watching our members dance. The DJ will announce that the club has tickets available for sale. An advertisement will be placed in the paper Thursday, February 10th and the event will be held Friday, February 11th from 6:00pm to 8:00pm.

Joni James mentioned to her silent auction committee members that she needs their collection sheets returned as soon as possible to her or Robin Anderson. They can email them to her at joni_james@med.unc.edu. In addition, she asked that if any club member wanted to give a donation to the silent auction to let her know.

Steve McHone mentioned that there was 200 tickets already out for the lawn buddy and that as soon as the money could be turned in, it would be helpful. In addition, he asked that he had some ½ hour slots available for members to sell tickets at MOW; anyone interested needs to contact him.

- SOS Spring Safari is April 22nd thru May 1st. The float committee will be handled by Brenda Smith she mentioned that a theme for the float has not been decided and asked that the club financially support the event. She asked for a \$700 pledge from the club that will be added to any corporate sponsors to help with the float activities. Joni James made the motion that the club pledge the \$700, Ronnie Gregory seconded the motion, there was no discussion and the members of the club passed the motion. In addition, Brenda said that anyone wanting to help with the float would be able to reach her on her cell at 336-684-3368. The parade will be held April 30th at 1:00pm and this will be The First Parade Of The Second Decade.
- Bylaws meeting will be held Tuesday, January 25th at 7:00pm, Sheila Walker's home.
- Fred Hallaman announced that there will be no party in Durham (Eno Shag Club) on the 22nd
- Sheila Walker told the membership of the club about a meeting that took place between BSC officers and the management of Ramada Inn.  able to sponsor four families this past year. One highlight the club could be proud of is
 that they provided a woman with heat for the cold months ahead; Bob stated that it would
 not have been made possible without the support and donations from club members.

- Sheila asked if there was any further business and the meeting was closed.
- Next Business meeting will be February 18th, location to be announced.



CHRISTMAS CHEER 2004

This year, the Shag Club adopted three (3) families as well as pitching in and buying a couple of gifts for our longtime family with (6) children. The Shag Club made money from the yard sale, which was matched by the Shag Club Treasury and we also received two anonymous donations from members for Christmas Cheer families.

Bob and I went to the Christmas Cheer office and looked through books of so many people that need help and we decided on two families with children and an elderly family. We decided to do our "one stop shopping at Wal-Mart" and Bob and myself, Pam McHone and Peg Hansen set out about 9:00 p.m. one night and gave it our best shot. Each of us took a family and the list and went in three different directions.

The elderly family consisted of a husband and wife who were in their 70's and a son who was 50 who was disabled living with them. Their only requests were fuel oil for heat and warm bedroom slippers for them and a warm shirt for their son. We called them and they only had very little fuel oil left and this was a very cold day in December, so we made the decision to stop by Alamance Oil Company on our way home and paid for 100 gallons of fuel oil to be delivered that day. When we told the lady, Ms. Doris that they were brining oil she cried......she must have thanked me 10 times. If ever the Shag Club has helped somebody that had to be at the very top of the list. We shopped for warm slippers and warm shirts and a small baby doll for their granddaughter and a turkey dinner for Christmas Day. They were so grateful when we delivered everything; what a feeling of joy when you see such gratitude on another person's face.

The second family was a single mother who had three (3) children and she had just had shoulder surgery and was unable to work. The children needed clothes very bad and they asked Santa for very few things. The mother was actually sharing a coat with the oldest daughter; there just wasn't enough money to buy two coats. We found lots of things on their lists for Santa and bought clothes, shoes and warm sweatshirts. We also bought the mother a warm coat of her very own along with a pair of shoes. We also provided them with a nice ham and fixins' for their Christmas Dinner.

Our third family was a single mother, living with her mother along with her two children. The children had a list for Santa and had asked for the normal stuff; Spiderman stuff for the little boy along with Hot Wheels and for his sister, CD's and a CD player. They needed warm clothing also and we were able to buy nice warm sweatshirts as well as shoes for both children. We also provided a nice ham and fixins' for their Christmas Dinner.

Each family was truly thankful and it was so obvious that their holiday season had been so special just because of us..........The Burlington Shag Club. Each year we think we had the "best" families ever and we say that it just can't get any better or any more heart warming, but each and every year we meet yet another family that leaves a special mark on us and we always walk away remembering something about those people. We cannot help but feel so truly grateful for what we as individuals have, but we also feel truly grateful for the wonderful opportunity to reach out and help people who are not as fortunate as we are.


