*Web Master* – Mary Gregory – Evelyn Turner suggested to Mary to put the date in which Sunshine information is posted to the website to let people viewing know when the posting was added to the web.

*Bus Trip Committee* – Denise & Chuck Upchurch – 2 vans with 21 people went to the Greensboro Area party, Burlington won for having the most people in attendance from one club.
