Secretary's Report: 187 members, thank you Evelyn Turner for doing the minutes for the September meeting. There were no changes or correction made, minutes stand.

Committee Reports:

DJ Committee – Kent Bradsher, Chair – Nothing to report at this time.

Sunshine/Remembrance Committee – Judy Lindley, Chair – Keep Edith Loy in thoughts and prayers, Mike Loy passed away.

Telephone Committee – Norma Long, Chair – Nothing to report at this time.

News Letter – Susan Huey, Editor – Need to get articles and information to Susan as soon as possible and no later than Tuesday the 25th.

Golf Committee – Chuck Upchurch & Clint Sharpe, Co-Chairs – Chuck read a letter from Amanda Powell thanking the club for the event; will try to get it published in Shag Rag. 45 sponsors were part of the tournament with a total profit of \$9,192.38. Sheila Walker and Steve McHone thanked the committee for a great tournament.

Ways & Means – Steve McHone, Chair – Tickets for cash raffle at the Christmas party are available to sell. \$500 will be given to the winning ticket, 300 tickets need to be sold, Steve wants each member to sell at least one pack. Ronnie and Mary Gregory have challenged membership to match their sales or out do them.

Web Master – Mary Gregory – Evelyn Turner suggested to Mary to put the date in which Sunshine information is posted to the website to let people viewing know when the posting was added to the web.

Bus Trip Committee – Denise & Chuck Upchurch – 2 vans with 21 people went to the Greensboro Area party, Burlington won for having the most people in attendance from one club. Approximately 35-40 members were in attendance. Van for Halloween party is being planned, see Denise for details. The reason a chartered bus has not been available for the past few events is due to the price of fuel. The club would need 40-45 people to ride the bus for it to be affordable.

They took a cash prize of \$80 that was collected between all bowlers

(from donations). The runners up were Jesse Justice, Hugh Walker, Sheila Walker, and Susan Huey. A great time was had by all and it has been suggested to do this event more than just once a year.

ACSC Summer Workshop 2006: Mary Gregory reported the advertising campaign was officially kicked off at SOS Fun Monday. Members passed out over 1500 workshop flyers and a lot of attention was given to the members who were dressed in their "Shag-Opoly" attire. The committee is now firming up all commitments for the workshop; this includes but is not limited to the freepours, DJs and sponsors. Individual committees have been meeting to discuss many details. The club also got two new members at that event.

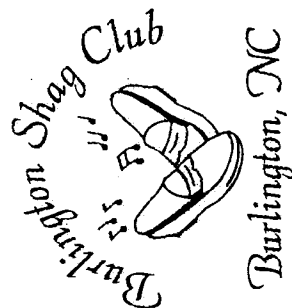

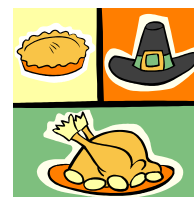
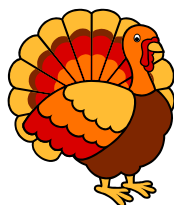
