- The BSC Business Meeting was brought to order by Jim West, President. He thanked Pam McHone and Baxter Sellars for doing such a great job arranging the cruise, Brenda Smith for arranging the transportation in Florida, and Carol Pettigrew for finding a hotel before leaving on the cruise. Everyone had a great time.
- Jim reported that a ladies jacket was missing from the Meals on Wheels
   Dance and asked if anyone had any information pertaining to such to contact
   him.
- The minutes from the January meeting were presented. One change was made to the minutes; add Sunshine Committee Chair, Carol Pettigrew. A motion was made and seconded to accept the January minutes with this change. Motion carried.
- 4. Jim noted that Michelle Thomas will be the Fun Monday Committee Chair.
- 5. June Graham, Treasurer, distributed the treasury report through February 15, 2008, indicating a balance of \$7,261.94. For the projected expenses for 2008, \$300.00 was removed for the Islander Shag Club Hospitality Room which was held in 2007. Also, \$1,000.00 allocated for 2008 Re-up Party was removed since this had occurred in January, 2008. It was noted that the \$500.00 from the yard sale was just a projection of the amount the club would match for Christmas Cheer. Treasury report was accepted.
- 6. Louise Flanigan, Vice President/Ways and Means Committee Chair, asked that each member choose three (3) ideas for the Ways and Means Committee to consider for a 2008 fundraiser for the club. She distributed a form to be filled out and returned following the meeting.
- 7. Ed Smith, Golf Committee Chair, asked for volunteers to serve on the committee. The Shamrock Golf Course has been booked for September 27, 2008. The Indian Valley Golf Course has submitted a proposal to host the golf tournament this year. This will be discussed by the committee at an upcoming meeting. Everyone is encouraged to help with this project.
- 8. Jim noted that the ACSC Winter Workshop is being held in Spartanburg, SC, on February 22-24 and encouraged all members to attend to show support for BSC.
- The DJ Throwdown is being held on February 28-March 2 at Myrtle Beach, SC. Our local DJ's Roy Childress and David Tuttle will be represented at Ducks
- 10. Kim Caldwell, DJ Chair, asked if DJ's should be scheduled for the two Friday nights during SOS. It was decided to schedule a DJ for April 18, but not for April 25 since the parade will be held on April 26
- 11. The April business meeting was changed from the 3rd Friday, April 18 to April 11.

- 12. Jim noted that BSC now has 172 members. Twenty-six of those are new members, some from years past. Pam McHone, Secretary, has ordered the new SOS cards for those who have already paid.
- 13. Stephanie West, Entertainment Committee Chair, asked for volunteers to serve on the entertainment committee to plan for the Area Shag Club Party, Halloween Party, and Christmas Party. She distributed a financial report for the Christmas Party and Area Shag Club Party for 2007. A motion was made to allocate \$1,500.00 for the Area Party and \$100.00 for a costume contest for the Halloween Party. The motion was seconded and carried. Last year \$1,700 was allocated for the Christmas Party. There was discussion concerning amount to be allocated for the party. A motion was made and seconded for the committee to bring costs of caterers for the event before making a decision on amount. Motion was seconded and carried.
- Ronnie Gregory, Float Committee Chair, spoke on behalf of the float for the SOS parade. A workshop will be held at his home on February 16.
- 15. Denise Upchurch, presented a proposal for a BSC Bowling Night for club members only. The event will be held on Saturday, March 29. The cost per person will be \$10.00. A motion was made to give \$200.00 to the first place team winners and \$100.00 to the second place team winners. Motion was seconded and passed.
- 16. The second session of the Junior Shag Lessons will begin March 1 at the Burlington Moose Lodge. This will be a 6-week session to run consecutive Saturdays excluding March 22 which is Easter weekend, ending April 12. The second session for the Adult Shag Lessons will begin February 29 and will run 3 weeks.
- 17. There was discussion of the next scheduled business meeting, March 21 since it will be Easter weekend. There was a motion and seconded to hold the meeting on March 21 due to other date conflicts.
- 18. Jim noted that Michelle Thomas will be the Fun Monday Chair for 2008.
- Jim encouraged everyone to support Eden's Area Shag Club Party on March 8. Check the website for more information.
- 20. Ronnie Gregory, MOW Chair, informed the club that we made over \$23,000 for Meals on Wheels. He thanked everyone for doing a wonderful job. There were over 500 people in attendance.
- 21. There will be an Active Adult Living Fair Dance Demo to be held at the Burlington Square Mall on April 15 from 9:00 a.m. 2:00 p.m. We have been approached to participate in this event. After some discussion, it was decided not to participate because of availability of dancers during that time period.
- 22. The Beach Buddy during MOW raised \$765.00 for the BSC
- 23. It was noted that the cost for our newsletter has been cut in half since members have agreed to receive by e:mail versus sending out mailings.
- 24. Jim asked if we had any other business for discussion.
- 25. Brenda Smith presented a Winter Escape Cruise for January 26 or 31. A motion was taken and seconded to promote a cruise for January 26 for the BSC.
- 26. Jonnie Ellington presented the minutes from the February 2nd Board of Director's Meeting. Next Board of Director's meeting to be held April 9. Location will be determined.
- 27. 50/50 drawing \$61.50 was won by Kay Detrick.
- 28. There being no other business, the meeting adjourned.

- \*to be responsible for disciplinary actions of the club membership, after the officers have addressed the issue


