- 1) The BSC business meeting for April was brought to order on Friday, April 11, 2008 by Jim West.
- 2) There were no new members present.
- 3) The BSC lost one of its members recently – Shirley Chambers passed away. Keep Shirley's family in everyone's prayers.
- 4) Pam McHone gave the Secretary's report for March and there was a correction to the minutes. The date for the Shagging for Hope will be held January 10, 2009. This was left off the minutes for March. After this correction, A motion to approve the minutes was made and they were approved.
- 5) Louise Flanagan presented the Treasurers report in June Graham's absence. Balance as of 4/11/2008 is \$5,814.79. A correction was noted for the projected expenses for 2008. The line item "Allocated for Jr. Shag Association should read "Burlington Jr. Shag Association".
- 6) Ronnie Gregory gave an update on the BSC float for the Spring SOS.. Float meeting to be held at Ronnie's home on 4/12/2008 to finalize the float. The float committee has worked very hard to accomplish great float for the parade. Thanks to everyone that helped.
- 7) Polly Tuttle announced she will have T-shirts after the business meeting.
- 8) The bowling tournament went well with 5-teams participating. The winning team was: Evelyn Turner, Jesse Justice, Stephanie West and Pat Hodgins. The 2nd place team was: Penny Simmons, Betty Honeycutt, Clint Sharpe and Ronnie McMannen.
- 9) Louise Flanagan gave a report on the Ways & Means Committee. The committee held a meeting on April, 3, 2008 to discuss ideas for raising money for the club. The committee members – Kathy & Dwight Cotton, Vicki & Tommy Stafford, Rick Turner (ORT); Kay & George Dedrick, Penny Simmons, Judy Smith and Jim & Stephanie West considered all suggestions. It was decided that a raffle be held. A gas grill will be the item to be raffled. The grill will be purchased from Lowes with a retail price of \$400.00. Lowes will give the club a \$100 discount and the tickets will be sold for \$5.00. Stephanie will print the raffle tickets (500 tickets) and the winning ticket will be drawn at the club Luau in June. A motion was carried to pre-sell the tickets immediately and at the Luau.
- 10) Louise also brought before the club the pancake supper and bake sale to be held on October 11, 2008 at the Homebuilders Shelter at the Burlington City Park. Jim West will verify if there are enough outlets in the building for cooking. The tickets will be \$5.00 and will be pre-sold. It was discussed how to advertise this event. Hugh & Shelia Walker will promote through their dance classes and we will contact WPCM to advertise on the radio. Local cable TV will also advertise for free. A motion was carried to have this event in October.
- 11) Stephanie West discussed the upcoming Luau. The committee met on Wed., April 9th to begin preparing for the Luau. The theme will be "Shipwrecked in Paradise". Steph asked for volunteers. There will be a \$500.00 cash prize raffle. There has been money allocated to buy meats and paper products. Members will be asked to bring various dishes.

- 15) The ACSC workshop will be hold July 11 – July 13th in Greenville, SC.
- 16) Michelle Thomas discussed Fun Monday for the fall SOS. A motion was carried to have a \$1,700 budget for this event which was what was allocated for last year.
- 17) The Danville Shag Club will host the Winter Workshop for 2009. The event will be held February 20 – 21, 2009. They have asked the Burlington Shag Club to host a hospitality room. A motion was made and carried. A motion was also made & carried for \$400 for the hospitality suite. Brenda Smith volunteered to head up committee for this event.
- 18) Angie Sharpe requested from the club to donate \$75.00 to purchase a brick for the new Meals on Wheels building. The brick will be on the walkway to the building with the BSC name on it. The motion was made and carried to donate \$75.00 for the brick.
- 19) The last date for the Junior shag lessons will be April 12, 2008 as reported by Stephanie West. A decision will be made at a later date if lessons will resume in the summer. Thanks to everyone who made this possible.
- 20) The adult shag lesson class beginning May 30th is full per Brenda Smith.
- 21) The entertainment committee will be having special Friday nights. July 18th will be "Hat Night".
- 22) Mary Gregory reported the "Who Am I" winner. There were several guesses but the first person to correctly guess was David Satterfield. The photo was of Bob Bason.
- 23) Carol Pettigrew asked for members to contact her (Sunshine) regarding illness or family deaths.
- 24) There is still time to book for the January, 2009 cruise. See Brenda Smith or contact All About Cruises in Burlington.
- 25) The winner of the 50/50 was Mary Gregory. Her winnings were \$68.00 and \$68.00 went to the club treasury.
- 26) A BSC board meeting will be held at the K&W Cafeteria on April 14th at 6:30 pm. All club members are invited to attend.
- 27) The next newsletter cutoff date is April 25th, 2008.
- 28) There was a \$35.00 donation from a BSC club member to Hospice in memory of Shirley Chambers.
- 29) Meeting was adjourned by Jim West.

BSC Board of Directors' Meeting 2 (April 14, 2008)

-Joan Kimbro opened the meeting by asking Jim West and Ronnie Gregory to explain the tax-exempt status for the BSC. They clarified that:

*35 % is the maximum the club can spend on charities; spending more can jeopardize our tax exemption if checked by the IRS;

*65% is to be spent on club membership;

*\$25,000 is the maximum amount to be retained in an account; retaining more will cause BSC to lose their tax exemption;

*this information was disseminated during the ACSC Winter Workshop in February of 2008;

*charities BSC donates to need to have running records kept in order to meet IRS regulations.

*MOWS and Special Olympics do not affect BSC treasury since the money collected for these organizations does not go through our account, but directly to the organizations.

-Joan emphasized that she thought it was a good idea that the members of the club are aware that they need to be recognized before speaking at our business meetings.

-Chuck Upchurch noted that Denise will video the float during the SOS parade; awards ceremony will be at Fat Harold's at 3:30 on April 26th.

-Meeting adjourned until July 21, 2008, at 6:30, at the K&W.

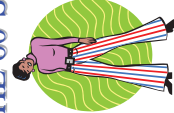

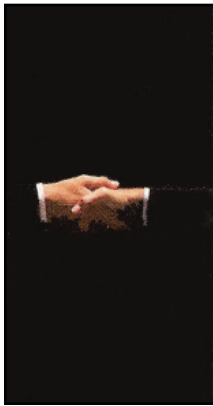

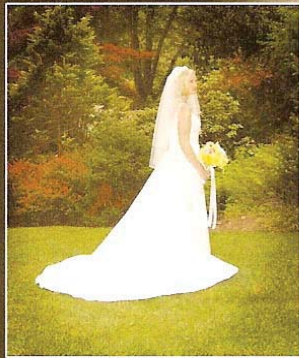
