- 1) The BSC business meeting for June was brought to order on Friday, June 20th, 2008 by Jim West. There was one new member in attendance – Welcome Cindy Sharpe...

- 3) Louise Flanigan presented the treasurer's report in June Graham's absence. The total deposits for the month were \$3,454.00 and total expenses were \$1,599.29 leaving a balance in the treasury of \$8,249.43.
- 4) Louise Flanigan reported raffle ticket sales for the gas grill were \$770.00
- 5) The Winston-Salem Shag Club 50's party will be held June 28th, 2008. Discussion was held regarding a van for the members. Jim was to check with Mike Wilson if this was possible.
- 6) The ACSC Summer Workshop will be July 11-13th in Greenville, SC
- 7) The next Board of Directors meeting will be at 6:30 pm July 21, 2008 at the K&W Cafeteria.
- 8) Jim informed the club that Ramada Inn cannot accommodate the BSC for the annual Membership Appreciation Pool Party this year. Jim also check in the Burlington Moose Lodge if we could have the event at their pool but was informed this pool is for Burlington Moose members only. Discussion was tabled until next month to see if there is a location for the event.
- 9) Michelle Thomas brought to the club items to be sold at Fun Monday at SOS. There were several items to choose from. Golf towel with shaggers or shag shoes, T-shirts, Huggers that hold water bottles or cans with Velcro, luggage tags, plastic fans and garden flags.
- 10) A discussion was held regarding the budget which was \$1,700 for Fun Monday items. A motion was made and passed to increase the budget to \$2,600.00
- 11) The club voted on the following items to be sold. T-shirts, Tank tops with moonlight shaggers, Plastic hand fans with moonlight shaggers and garden flags. These items will be pre-sold before the fall SOS.
- 12) Jim West has Fun Monday tickets for members to sell.
- 13) Ed Smith discussed the upcoming Golf Tournament to benefit Special Olympics. He asked members to think about a large item to raffle at the tournament.

- 14) Jim asked for a volunteer to head up committee for the annual yard sale to raise money for Christmas Cheer. This was tabled until next meeting.
- 15) Jim asked for a volunteer to chair the Meals on Wheels benefit in February. Joan Kimbro has spoke with Al Fogleman regarding helping with this event. Al agreed to co-chair event but no one volunteered to co-chair with Al. Jim will call Al Fogleman to discuss. This was tabled until next meeting.
- 16) Mary Gregory asked BSC members to step forward and volunteer for upcoming events.
- 17) Mary discussed the BSC website and the amount of visitors each month. June has approximately 41,000 hits. There is a guestbook on the website for visitors to sign. (burlingtonshagclub.com)
- 18) Louise Flanigan discussed the proposed pancake supper to raise money for the club. The location was to be at the Homebuilders Shelter at the Burlington City Park. The City of Burlington requires a \$2,000,000 insurance policy for users of the shelter and there were not enough electrical outlets to support the equipment necessary for cooking. This event is on hold until further notice.
- 19) Louise Flanigan & Penny Simmons have chosen a publishing company for the BSC cookbook. See Penny or Louise for the recipe cards for member to furnish for the cookbook. Recipes need to be turned in by August 1, 2008 for the cookbooks to be ready by Christmas. A minimum of 200 cookbooks to be sold at \$3.00/cost. A motion was made and carried to sell the cookbooks to raise money for the club.
- 20) Stephanie West thanked her committee for everyone's hard work on the Luau. There were approximately 392 people in attendance and estimated income was \$1,500.00
- 21) The winner of the "Who Am I" contest was Louise Flanigan. She correctly guessed the photo was Mary Gregory.
- 22) Carol Pettigrew reported on the Sunshine Committee. David Tuttle was in the hospital with chest pains but was released on Friday, June 20th. Good news for David – All was OK
- 23) David Satterfield commended the Luau Committee for the good food at the party.
- 24) The cut-off for articles for the newsletter is June 25th
- 25) Brenda Smith updated the club regarding the January, 2009 cruise. Next installment is August 1st. Cabins are still available. See Brenda or call All About Cruises in Burlington if interested.
- 26) The winner of the 50/50 was Wayne Vincent – Hit winnings were \$41.50.
- 27) Meeting was adjourned.

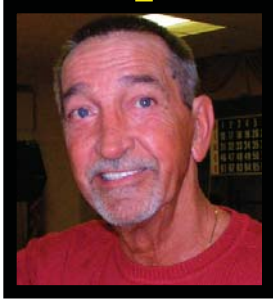

Wesley Harrison May (Wes)

Most people in the shag world have heard of or taken shag lessons from Wes. He has taught over 25,000 people. This is amazing! He has taken 52 couples from Amateur to Pro in his career. This is also amazing! Wes has competed in shag contests for 27 years and is still competing.

Wanda Holliday Yow and Wes competed this year in the Master's Division of the South Carolina National Shag Dance Championships. He has danced in this competition for 13 years. Before the Competitive Shaggers Association, Wes competed in many, many contests when a couple had to dance 4 times. He went from Amateur to Pro in only 7 contests. Once he joined the CSA, he continued dancing contests and won the "Endurance award" 5 times. To win an "endurance award", you must dance every contest within the year. He also judges contests (too many to mention). Not only is Wes a dancer and a judge; he is an instructor.

Wes has taught shag to groups and individuals for about 30 years. He has taught in Memphis, Nashville, Richmond, Washington, DC; many cities in South Carolina and all over North Carolina from Boone to Atlantic Beach. He has taught workshops to as many as 250 people but still loves it when an individual asks him to show them something. He is always willing to teach for any charitable event. He loves the dance, the music and the shaggers. So, if you are out, he will not be too busy to help you. Needless to say, all of this has brought attention to Wes.

Wes was inducted into the National Living Legends of Dance in 1999. He has been nominated for SC Shagger's Hall of Fame, SC Living Legends and Atlantic Beach Shagger's Hall of Fame. It's just a matter of time before he will be inducted into these organizations too.

Although Wes lives in Smithfield, he frequents us here in Burlington where he grew up. He is also a member of our club. If you don't know him, say hello and ask for a step.

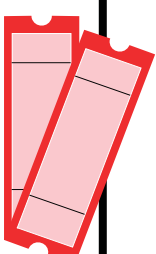

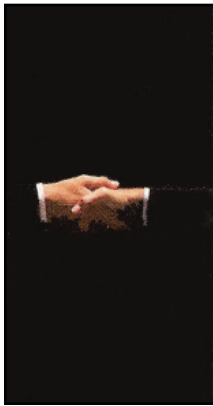

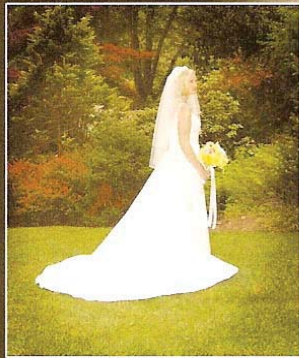
