- 1. Jim West opened the meeting at 8:04 p.m. No new members were in attendance.
- 2. The minutes were presented and approved as submitted, but it was later 10. Shag Lessons Adult We will continue to offer noted that a correction needed to be made to the notation regarding the cookbooks. This was item #19 and should have read "A minimum of 200 cookbooks will be sold at \$10.00 each. The Club's cost on the cookbooks will be \$3.00 each."
- 3. June presented the treasury report. We currently have \$6,906.26 in our funds. A copy of the report was distributed to members just before the meeting began. June also reminded members that she needs all receipts for any club expenses.
- 4. There will be a Board of Directors meeting on Monday, July 21, 2008 at 6:30 at the K&W Restaurant. This is open to members of the club.
- 5. Membership Appreciation Party No place has been found yet for a pool party, but the search is still on. Jim suggested that maybe we could just have a cookout somewhere. We cannot use the facilities at the Moose Lodge if we are not members. Jim also noted that any event at the Moose Lodge not booked before May will have to have insurance coverage. Brenda advised that there may be a policy available which was discussed at the Summer Workshop. A suggestion was also made to check out the Homebuilders Shelter. Jim said he would get a meeting together and try to find some possibilities. Sheila noted that the hotel located beside the Shrine Club might be a possibility for a pool party.
- 5. Fun Monday Jim received a letter from "Barb" saying that Twisters would be giving away fans at Fun Monday and that our club should reconsider selling fans. Brenda spoke to Mike Rink of Twister's Club and he said they were not going to be giving away fans. We have already made a deposit on the fan we had planned to sell, so we will have them anyway. Ours will have a picture of shaggers on it and not a club name. Michelle said our Fun Monday items will be ready in August. She also has a sign-up sheet for members to volunteer to help in the booth.
- 6. Jim stated that at the last meeting we discussed needing committee heads for two main events - the Yard Sale and Meals On Wheels. He said that Al Fogleman would co-chair the Meals On Wheels Benefit if needed. Brenda Smith volunteered to chair the Yard Sale event and asked that members start accumulating items now. It was voted to have the yard sale on Saturday, October 11th. Location will advised at a later date and also a drop off point for items. Ronnie Gregory volunteered to chair the Meals On Wheels event for 2009. He will be working on an agenda and will call a meeting to get things started.
- 7. Pancake supper fund raiser Louise Flanigan can get the Graham Civic Center for us to use. There would be a \$50 deposit, which would be returned to the club. It will cost the club \$105 to use the building. The members voted to have a pancake supper fund raiser on Saturday, October 18th, 4:30-7:30. No alcohol will be allowed.
- 8. Cookbook Penny Simmons and Louise advised they needed the recipes returned to them by August 1st. The cookbook should be ready before Christmas. If you need more forms, please see Penny or Louise.
- 9. Shag Lessons Juniors Because the attendance dwindled off for the Junior lessons, Jim asked if the club wanted to continue to offer them.

- David Satterfield noted that while it is great for them to learn the shag, there is no where around here for them to dance so he made a motion that for now, we discontinue the Junior lessons. The motion was seconded and vote passed to discontinue. Brenda said there are ways that the club could contribute to the Ellen Taylor Foundation, which is a support group for juniors, by donation of shoes or in other ways. Stephanie West reminded the members that we have \$300 in our treasury set aside for the junior program. A motion was made to donate this to the Junior Shag Association. Brenda also accepted an SOS Parade CD on behalf of the club for winning in the Best Shag Theme category.

- 14. SOS cards Jim advised if you need a card for Fall Migration that you should to contact Pam McHone or you can wait and obtain a card at SOS.

- 16. The newsletter cut-off is July 25th.

This was a highlight of the meeting and very entertaining. Awards of DVD's were given out to the SOS Spring Safari Parade winners and Burlington Shag Club received a huge round of applause for our accomplishment in winning "The Best Shag Theme" for 6 years in a row! A new shag club was voted into full membership, and as customary for some time now, Dr. Phil Sawyer ended the meeting with one of his famous jokes.

An ACSC/SOS Workshop is filled with good times, good friends, great memories, and valuable information to help us understand more fully the purpose of our organization and the challenges we are facing. If you want to get to know the movers and shakers in the ACSC/SOS - the workshops are the place to do it. 


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#### **Burlington Shag Club Christmas Cheer Yard Sale**
