

Each person attending will have their labs drawn for a PSA test and also have the physical exam by one of the area Urologist. There is no charge for this service. If a charge would be attached, it would amount to approximately \$300.00 total.

I know that this is not an exam that is enjoyed, but please take the time to have this done either during this annual screening or at your local physician's office. Prostate Cancer is curable if diagnosised early. Last year there were 350 men who attended this screening and there were four out of those screened who were diagnosed.
