- 1) The BSC business meeting for August was brought to order on Friday, August 15, 2008 by Jim West. There were no new members present.
- 2) Pam McHone gave the Secretary's report for July. Thanks to Evelyn Turner who took minutes for the July meeting in Pam's absence. There were no corrections noted by the members. A motion was made to approve the minutes. Current membership is 213 members.
- 3) June Graham presented the Treasurer's report as of 8/15/2008. Balance as of this date is \$5,952.89. There were a total of \$68.00 deposits and a total of \$1,021.37 in expenses for the month.
- 4) Ed Smith reported on the upcoming Golf Tournament for Special Olympics. Breakfast will be provided by Biscuitville and lunch will be provided by Ham's. Ed reported that donations are coming in as well as some door prizes. He asked members to solicit businesses to become sponsors. Ed also asked for volunteers to help on the day of the tournament.
- 5) Jim addressed the membership appreciation party. He spoke with the Moose Lodge and they will allow BSC to have a cookout on their property. The pool cannot be used. After discussion by club members, a motion was made to not have a membership appreciation party. This motion was passed and club decided to not have the appreciation party.
- 6) The club voted to have the annual tea party on the 1st Saturday at SOS from 3-5 pm.
- 7) Ronnie Gregory made a motion to increase the allocated money for the SOS Tea party from \$500 to \$750.00. This motion was not carried.
- 8) The allotted amount for the tea party is \$500.00
- 9) Judy Satterfield discussed issues with non-members getting drinks at the SOS tea party. She also asked members to assist in the tip for the tea party. There was an anonymous donor last year that gave \$100.
- 10) David Satterfield discussed not having DJ's at the club on certain dates.- July 4th, SOS, etc.
- 11) The Winston-Salem Area Shag Club Pool Party will be held Saturday, August 23, 2008
- 12) The Greater Triad Area Shag Club Party will be held October 4, 2008
- 13) The Danville Area Shag Club Party will be held November 22, 2008
- 14) Fun Monday was discussed by Mary Gregory in Michelle Thomas' absence. The fans are in and there were some examples for club members to view. There will be pre-sales of the items for members to purchase before SOS.

- 16) Ronnie Gregory reported on the first Meals on Wheels meeting. The event will be held on February 14th, 2009. The Craig Woolard Band will be performing and the DJ's will be: Rick Turner, Jim Wayne, and David Tuttle. More details to follow.

- 17) The next Board of Directors meeting will be at 6:30 pm October 20th, 2008 at the K&W Cafeteria..
- 18) Tabled from last month was the \$300 for the Burlington Junior Shaggers. Denise Upchurch expressed a desire to head this program up again next year and the \$300 will be held until that time
- 19) Louise Flanigan reported on the Ways & Means Committee- The Cookbook project is going very well. There have been 300 recipes received from members and these are going to the publishing company this week. We will receive the cookbooks in approximately 10-12 weeks. Louise recognized her committee of : Penny Simmons, Stephanie West, June Graham, Judy Smith, Vickie Stafford, Kay Dedrick, Jonnie Ellington and Evelyn Turner for all of their hard work in getting this project underway. Handouts were given for members to order cookbooks. There will be an order of 300 cookbooks and the cost per book to the club is \$3.10. The club will sell for \$10.00. Our cost will be \$930 + any shipping and handling. The publishing company will send us 3% extra cookbooks (9 extra cookbooks will generate \$90). If all 300 are sold our profit will be \$2,070.00. The Burlington Shag Club logo will be on the cover. (The dancers). The title of the cookbook is "Cooking with the Burlington Shag Club"
- 20) David Satterfield reported on the adult shag lessons. Attendance is going well and this group will finish on Friday, August 22nd. September 5th there will be a mirror step class for BSC members and non members.

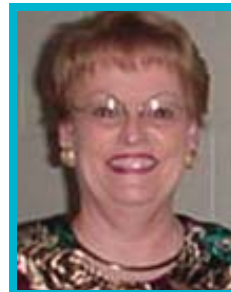

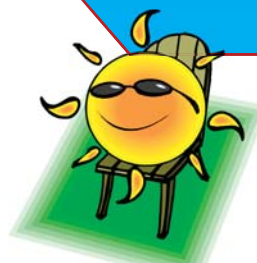

On **Tuesday, September 23rd** the annual **prostate screening** fair will be held at the Cancer Center at ARMC. The screening will begin at 6:00 PM. Each person attending will have their labs drawn for a PSA test and also have the physical exam by one of the area Urologist. There is no charge for this service. If a charge would be attached, it would amount to approximately \$300.00 total.

I know that this is not an exam that is enjoyed, but please take the time to have this done either during this annual screening or at your local physician's office. Prostate Cancer is curable if diagnosed early. Last year there were 350 men who attended this screening and there were four out of those screened who were diagnosed. All three are doing well today because they took the time to get their screening. So remember September 23rd beginning at 6:00 PM at the Cancer Center at ARMC, you do not have to pre register. 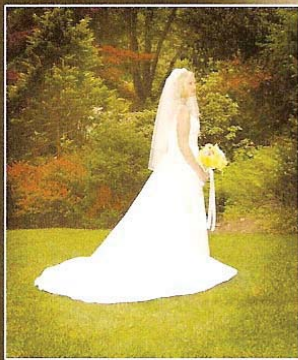
