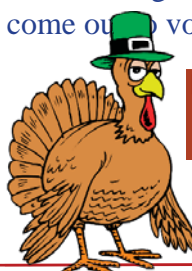

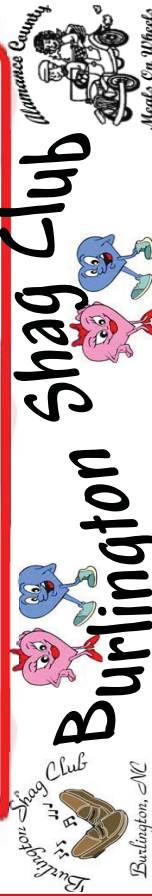

## The Results are in! This Year's Christmas Cheer Yard Sale was the Best Ever!

I am so humbled by the outpouring of support from our members this year for our 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Christmas Cheer Yard Sale. We had so many quality items donated and an overwhelming number of members came out to help the day of the sale. The weather was beautiful for our event, and we all had such good fellowship together as we worked for the common goal of helping families in our community during the Christmas season.

The night before the sale, 10 faithful members gathered beginning at 6:30 pm and ending at 11:00 pm to unload and organize the vast amount of Clothes, Household Items, Electronics, Fitness Equipment, and Children items. The trailer was full, all the way to the door, with the donations. We had prepared by gathering 8 tables for the goods but soon realized we needed more than what we had in order to properly display all the items. We were able to get more tables and proceeded to unpack the mountain of boxes from the truck. This was by far the most efficient means of setting up this event as the display was set and ready for the next morning. At 7:00 am, it was still quite dark when we started selling to early shoppers with flashlights and as the sun rose with no clouds in the horizon, the shoppers continued to pour in. We had huge crowds all through the morning and the parking lot remained full with overflow parking on the side of the adjoining roads. There were very few people who came to the sale that walked away without buying something. In fact, when some shoppers realized why we were having the yard sale, many reached into their pockets or purses and donated more money to our cause.

There were 28 members who showed up to help and/or shop. It was obvious, as everyone wore huge smiles and as the constant laughter filled the area, all in attendance were thoroughly enjoying themselves throughout the morning. We ended the sale around 1:00 pm, packed and reloaded the trailer with the remainder of the items, which we donated to Hospice. We all had the feeling that this sale was going to set a record and we were right. The total sales of the day equaled \$1,227.89! After paying for the newspaper advertising, our total deposit to the club Treasury was \$1,187.89.

Can you believe we almost did not have our annual Christmas Cheer Yard Sale this year? I am so glad we did! All the hard work was well worth the effort! While I have not chaired this event each year, I have worked this event each year, and in all 6 years combined, we have raised in excess of \$4000 in total! As a result of the sale's success this year, we do not have to dip into the club treasury to support our Christmas Cheer efforts, which allows the existing funds in our club's treasury to be used for the start up expenses of the coming year.

The success of this event is the result of true teamwork. Thanks to all who searched through their homes, attics, garages, out buildings and appealed to friends, family, and co-workers to donate items and to all who came out and helped unload and/or sell items during the event. Thank you to TST Trucking and Trailer Rental for donating the use of a trailer for the storage of the items. Additionally, I have to recognize and thank Ramada Inn for allowing us to hold the event on their property and consenting to have the storage trailer in their parking lot to receive the donations. Our success is your success and, more importantly, the Burlington Shag Club will sponsor and help families in need during the Christmas season again in 2008.

**The following is a proposal to change Section IV. B. - It was proposed to delete Number 2. and renumber 3. - 8. to be 2. - 7.**

**Here is the way it reads NOW:**

#### **IV. ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE**

- A. The officers of the club are: President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Sergeant At Arms; elected from the general membership as prescribed by these by-laws and by the parliamentary authority adopted by the club.
- B. The Board of Directors will consist of nine (9) members and will be comprised of the current officers and elected at large members.
  - 1. Elected members will serve a two-year term. If a position should come open, the vacancy can be filled at a general membership meeting.
  - 2. **Elected members cannot hold any chairmanship of the club for the duration they are on the Board.**
  - 3. The Chairman and Vice-Chairman cannot be one of the current officers.
  - 4. Members on the Board will vote on the Chairman and Vice-Chairman and who will take minutes for their meetings.
  - 5. The duties of the Board of Directors are:
    - a. To be responsible for all legal and liability issues of the club.
    - b. To be responsible for disciplinary actions of the club membership.
  - 6. There will be four (4) required meetings each year. These will be held the first month of each quarter. Other meetings can be called as necessary.
  - 7. The Board of Directors meetings are open to the general membership, but no one from the general membership can be a part of any votes taken at these meetings.
  - 8. Minutes of the Board meetings will be presented at the next general membership meeting.

**It is proposed to read as follows after deleting Line B #2.**


#### **IV. ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE**

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  - 6. The Board of Directors meetings are open to the general membership, but no one from the general membership can be a part of any votes taken at these meetings.
  - 7. Minutes of the Board meetings will be presented at the next general membership meeting.

**We will be voting on the above proposed ByLaws change at our next Business Meeting on November 21, 2008.**
