- . The January BSC business meeting was brought to order by Ronnie Gregory at 8 pm on January 23, 2009. Four new members were present, JT and Cindy Smith, and Bill and Linda Allred. There was no guests present. Ronnie asked Jim West to come up and he presented Jim with a Past President's pin from ACSC and thanked Jim for a great job as Past President.
- . The minutes from the November business meeting were passed as published in the Shag Rag. Carol Pettigrew reported that we currently have 247 members with 19 of this number being new members. - . Stephanie West reported on our Christmas Party. Over 200 guest in attendance. \$1,635 was spent on the party and we made \$1,668 for a profit of \$33. Ronnie thanked Stephanie for doing a great job on organizing the party.
- . Brenda Smith spoke about the Christmas Cheer Families. Five families were adopted and Christmas Cheer was provided for with funds raised from our yard sale. \$1,186 was allocated to spend on the families with another \$300 given by an anonymous donor for a total of \$1,486 to be spent on the families. There was \$68 left over and returned to club treasury.
- . Due to Joan Kimbro's absence, Ronnie spoke about our Christmas float for 2008. Lots of people participated and it was a huge success.
- . Louise Flanigan reported on cook book sales. Total profit on cookbooks was \$2,179 and with profits made on grill at Luau, total profit from Ways and Means for year was \$2,630.15. Ronnie thanked Louise and her committee for all their hard work.
- . Ed Smith reported on Golf Tournament. Modern Woodsmen matched up to \$2,500 which made our total profit for the golf tournament \$8,200.
- . Sheila Walker asked about the club membership deadline. According to by laws, January 31 is deadline. Motion was made to extend the deadline to February 6 and to waive the \$5.00 fee due to many people being out of town. Motion was passed.
- She also brought up for discussion about shag club purchasing a portable AED unit. Ronnie asked Sheila to get more information on this and report back the next meeting.
- . Ronnie said Mid Winter was very cold but lots of fun with a large number of our members there in attendance.
- . He also stated that the next and final MOW meeting will be held on February 2, at Ramada at 6:00 pm. We still need sponsors and tickets are \$25 now and will be \$30 at the door of Ramada.
