Don't forget that this Friday night, April 3rd. is our business meeting night due to SOS and Easter. Hope everyone will have a Happy Easter. Keep on dancing....

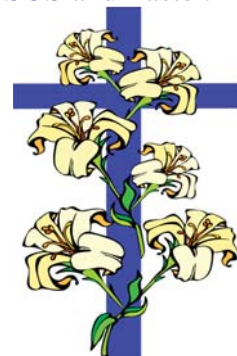

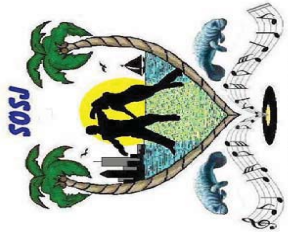
