Burlington Shag Club Board of Directors Sixth Meeting April 8, 2009

The Burlington Shag Club Board of Directors meeting was called to order by Joan Kimbro at 6:45pm. Joan opened the meeting with a discussion on the AED unit. She introduced Bud Cato with the Burlington Fire Department. He discussed the liability and said you can be sued by anyone for anything. He said you are covered under 2 laws: 1) CASA 2000 Cardiac Arrest Survival Act which states that every Federal Building must have a defibulator in it and any person helping is covered as long as they are acting in good faith. 2) The Good Samaritan Law in which you are covered as long as you act in good faith in what you are trained to do. Bud stated that the Battery for the AED is good for 10 years or 100 shocks. Pads are around \$20 and have an expiration of 1 year and you can use them one time. Survival rate with an AED is about 80% and without is about 7%. He stated that he would train us on CPR and AED at NO charge, whether we bought an AED or not. Joan will let the Club know of our discussion at the next Business Meeting.

Joan passed out Tort laws, Red Cross information and Good Samaritan Law info and asked everyone to take and read. The meeting was adjourned at 8:05pm.
