What if you knew of an event that would:

That event is the annual Prostate Cancer Screening to be held, Tuesday, September 22nd from 6:00 – 9:00 p.m. at the Alamance Regional Cancer Center at Alamance Regional Medical Center. Several local urologists will be on hand to administer digital rectal exams. There will also be staff available to draw blood for the PSA blood test. Men over the age of 40 are encouraged to drop by for this free screening. No appointment is necessary.

As you may know, those with prostate cancer have a good cure rate if the cancer is detected early. If left untreated, prostate cancer invades the bones and prognosis becomes bleak. This annual screening has uncovered at least one diagnosis of cancer each year.

The same services offered at the screening would cost as much as \$250.00 in a doctor's office. This screening is FREE.


