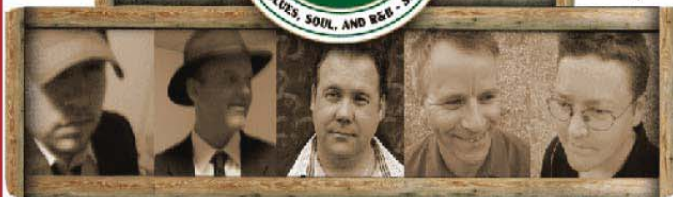
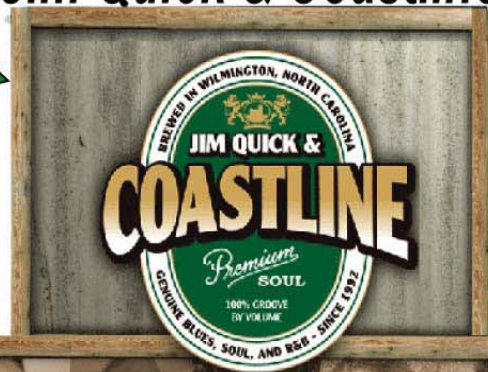

The night before the sale, 9 faithful members gathered beginning at 6:00 pm and ending at 10:00 pm to unload and organize the huge amount of Clothes, Household Items, Electronics, Furniture, and Children’s’ items. Beginning at 7:00 AM with a forecast of rain all day, it was still quite dark when we started selling to early shoppers with flashlights and as the daylight emerged, the shoppers poured in to dig for bargains and find their treasure amongst our goods. We had huge crowds all through the morning and the parking lot remained full with overflow parking on the side of the adjoining roads. There were very few people who came to the sale that walked away without a smile and something to take home with them.

Thank you to TST Trucking and Trailer Rental for donating the use of a trailer for the storage of the items. Additionally, I have to recognize and thank Stephen Stearns for allowing us to hold the event on the Stearns Ford property and consenting to have the storage trailer in their parking lot to receive the donations. Steven was also very helpful in advertising for the event. I even heard the event was posted on Craig’s List! I would like to thank Ed and Patty Smith for their generous donation to help round up our amount to use for Christmas Cheer this year to an even \$1000.

This year’s Yard Sale/Christmas Cheer should be considered your success and, more importantly, the Burlington Shag Club will sponsor and help 4 families in need during the Christmas season in 2009. In addition, with the help of the Decorating Committee and the Candy Christmas Tree Sale, we will be visiting “The Homeplace”, an assisted living facility, on Saturday, December 19 at 2:30 to spread some additional Christmas Cheer. Won’t you come and participate in an exhibition dance and visit a few of the elderly afterwards? Please give me a call if you have any questions. I would be more than happy to give you more information.

The Christmas Cheer Yard Sale is hard work for those that help load, unload, organize, sell, and for those that comb through their attics, closets, buildings, and garages looking for items to donate to this cause. All the hard work is well worth the effort! When I suggested this venue during a business meeting in 2003, I did not realize the impact the Yard Sale would have over the next several years. Since 2003, we will have helped 24 families who would have had very little to celebrate during the holiday season without the assistance we have provided them. While I have not chaired the Yard Sale event each year, I have worked during the sale every year and have been Christmas Cheer Chairman for 5 years. In all of our Yard Sales combined, our club has raised \$5,003.17 for Christmas Cheer! Yep, there is still truth to that old saying, “One man’s trash is another man’s treasure”. Using the money we raise for Christmas Cheer, that old saying has real meaning with substance!

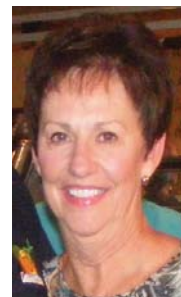
