- **Joan recognized Louise Flanigan** for presenting the birthday honors for our members each month.
- **Float:** Joan reported that we have another \$343.41 that has come in, along with the \$300.00 for the winning prize.
- **Luau:** Laverne Martin stated that the Luau was a great success with 450 in attendance. The beach buggy raffle took in \$1364.00, with an expense of only \$141.00. Jesse Justice took in \$1150.00 for the 50/50. With money from the door and an additional \$63.00 for our "Hula Hoochies", we made a profit of \$2,869.61. Everyone had a great time.
- **Fayetteville Workshop:** Per Mary Gregory, the coalition members who are participating in the hospitality room plan to wear their coalition t-shirts. The workshop is also offering evening tickets for the first time at only \$20.00 per each night session.
- **Dance lessons:** David and Judy Satterfield will be holding 2 more scheduled dance classes. The next one is scheduled for 6/25 at 8 o'clock for the basic and the last scheduled lesson is for 7/9/10.
- **Membership Appreciation Pool Party and Reunion Party:** Joan stated that the pool party is scheduled for 8/21/10 at Ramada Inn. Since money and scheduling is tight, she has suggested that we combine the membership party with the reunion party. Kim Hodge and Baxter Sellars have agreed to chair the pool party. Current members will be free, with a \$5.00 charge for guest or non-members. No coolers or glass containers are allowed inside the fenced in area. You can leave your

coolers along the fence outside the pool area. We will have hot dogs and hamburgers, along with some BBQ left from the luau. Ramada is allowing us to eat inside the fenced in area this year, as long as we clean up after ourselves. If not, they will accessed a \$150.00 clean up fee. They are also giving us the shag rate of \$59.00 for rooms if you decide to stay. House DJs normally take turns providing music. Joan asked that those interested in playing let her know. We will need some tents, tables and chairs. Also, we will need volunteers to bring desserts. The pool party is technically from 1-4, with food being served starting around 1:15 - 1:30. Joan will also check on

beginning the pool party at 11:00 instead of 1:00. Those with rooms will start early. The party will start at 9:00 in the lounge since we cannot play music until the restaurant closes. We will only be having a cake, balloons and finger snacks in the lounge. No hot foods allowed. Combining the two parties will help to reduce the over-all costs involved. Judy Smith made a motion to combine the parties and move forward as presented. Butch Dowd seconded. All approved.

Reunion party : Shelia Walker presented that we would be mailing approximately 300 invitations, while sending some invitations via email will reduce the overall postage costs. We have the potential for 300-500 people show up for the night time party. We will have minimal decorations, and have tables set up recognizing our HOF, Past Presidents and for the display of our float trophies. We might have some door prizes. Sheila asked that we earmark the \$1000.00 that was budgeted. After discussing, LaVerne Martin made a motion to budget \$500.00 for the party, if needed. Evelyn Turner seconded. Majority approved. The question of the capacity of Masters was brought up. Jim West went and found out that it was 150. Per Joan, we can have the Carolina Room for \$300.00 or ½ of the Ballroom (1/2 with stage and dance floor) for \$600.00. Per Ramada, if we rent out 25 rooms at the hotel that day, then there would be no charge for the Carolina Room. Joan to see if there would be any reduction in the Ballroom costs with the booking of the 25 rooms. She will also find out what the capacity in those two rooms is. If we do take those rooms, they will need to provide security and bartenders. We have approval to ask Jim Parker to provide security if he is willing. Joan will also find out the drop dead date for reserving rooms and making a final decision.

Fall SOS Coalition Party: Kim Hodge is selling the t-shirts. We will have the party on the Sunday in the same location as last year.

Fun Monday: Kim Caldwell presented the items for selling at our tent. She has ordered the coolers and flags. She passed around the design for the aprons. This will be printed on khaki and white aprons. All approved of the design. Kim also showed the shoe bags that Evelyn has sewn and embroidered. Evelyn will sell them to us for \$7.00 and we will sell them in the tent for \$12.00. There will only be 20 of these bags on offer. Per Kim, registration for our booth is on schedule. Please sign up to work a shift in the tent and sell your Fun Monday tickets!!!! Pat Hodgkin made a motion to accept these designs and items presented for sale, Ed Smith seconded. All approved. We will have a pre-sale at the August meeting.

Fall SOS Tea Party: Do we want this at the Arcade? Someone suggested that we check into the price for Pirate's Cove again. Joan will check into this. Butch Dowd made the motion that we have the tea party and Judy Satterfield seconded. Majority approved.

Golf Tournament: Steven Stearns stated that the next planning meeting is being held on 7/13/10 at Masters at 6:30. The tournament date has been moved to 10/9/10.

Christmas Party: Evelyn Turner has agreed to chair this committee. The party will be held on 12/11/10. They are considering a change of location to the Ramada Inn. If we do it there, will they give us the same costs and room consideration if we rent out the 25 rooms? Joan will check on that.

50/50: Evelyn Turner was the 50/50 winner of \$67.00.






