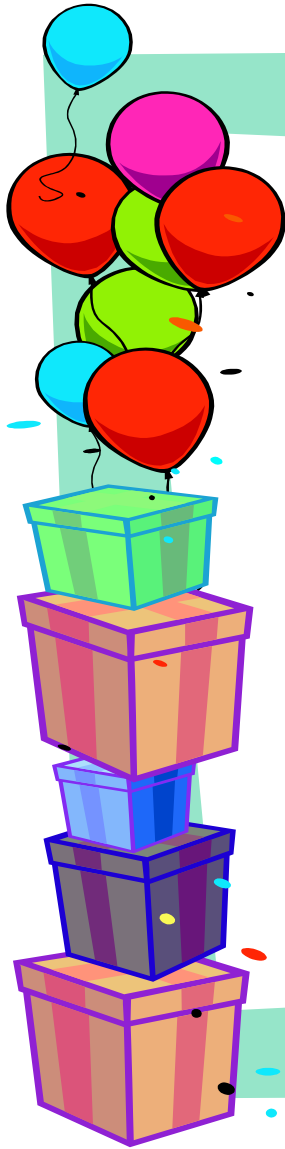

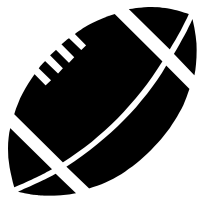

Thru the Looking Glass

Mike was standing on the Graham court Square corner with one foot propped on the fire hydrant in front of Graham Soda Shop (now a memorial park). He was talking to high school friends and I was walking with a mutual friend from Belk's (on Harden Street) one spring Saturday of 1957. I was headed to a small restaurant across the street from the Soda Shop for lunch when my friend stopped to say hello and we were introduced. That afternoon at work, I received a phone call from him asking me to break my date that night and date him. I replied "no, you break your date Sunday night", he replied "NO". I then said forget you and that is where the call ended.

The next week Mike went to Kenai Alaska to start his army security tour of duty and in June I received a letter from him after he had seen my picture in the local Burlington paper that his mother was sending him. This started a two-year friendly weekly writing – he was in Alaska and I was in nursing school at the NC Baptist Hospital in Winston Salem.

He came home May of 1959 and after seven weeks of dating I was wearing a diamond engagement ring and finishing another year of nursing school. As we planned our wedding for July 3, 1960, he revealed that he told an army buddy he knew me and bet \$0.50 I would write him back. My title became his \$0.50 street walking bride. He really had a great sense of humor and lots of old sayings such as "better than a slice of bread" or useless as shoes on a snake."

Our married life brought many changes with both of us going back to college at different times, buying our first cars (staying awake at night wondering how we would pay for them), buying our first home, having children, work promotions, changing jobs, moving, and playing cute jokes on each other. We grew up playing with our two daughters, taking pictures, riding bikes, renting a house to carry two car loads of young people to Atlantic beach every summer, riding motorcycles, going on family trips and reunions, to staying home as parents when our daughters started dating. He was always awake till the last one came home and the door was locked. Most important was the influences that God and church had on our family and life. Our daughters married and moved out and we were at last alone looking at each other with a feeling of being lost.

Then our fun began again. We seen an Ad in the Burlington paper "Local Shag Lessons." At the completion of the lesson we were invited to the Burlington Shag Club Christmas dance at the lodge in Elon. At the dance, we were confused because we weren't doing what the club was doing, but some kind of bounce of the body and steps to the beat.

Back to lessons this time in Greensboro with the difficulty of first unlearning what we originally taught to what really was the shag steps. This was a challenge and we were so bad that we had to prevent many arguments by carrying the video camera to class with us so we could go home and practice for the next lesson. Every time we rode in the car, the radio was playing music as we recited "*up two-three, back two-three, kick two-three.*"

We joined the Burlington Shag Club and each of you became our friends and extended family. In 1991 he was elected President and worked so hard that year writing and producing the "Shag Rag" plus settling constant personality problems between a few. In 1992 due to a sudden job change out of town, he had to resign from several years as the club's president.

Grandchildren came along and we were back in the stay at home family setting.

In 1997, Mike had a stroke without major harm, except his left foot became his right foot and this ended up as a family joke. It was often said, "Do you mean a Flanigan left or right?" In 1998 he retired as a mechanical design engineer from Engineered Control – Rock Creek. 1999 brought a heart attack with heart damage and complications that demanded back surgery. 2000 brought gallbladder surgery and then in 2001, I became jealous of all his attention and ended up having right heel surgery. Can you believe 2001 and 2002 we had two blissful years together always enjoying special shag events such as Meals On Wheels, Christmas party, and SOS. Each of you was so special in our lives, friendly, accepting us for who we were and making us feel important in your lives.

Then the big blow came: Mike got sick suddenly in June of 2003 and had the big horrible "C" diagnosis. For two short months we prayed together, cried, talked, laughed, and never losing our faith in God. His life slipped away from him August 1, 2003. Once again the Burlington Shag Club was there for us during his illness and death. You cried with us, called, sent cards, visited, brought food, and attended the visitation and funeral.

But the Burlington Shag Club did not stop – you made one feel so loved at the Christmas party (12/13/2003) with your love, hugs, caring words, and embracing as the tears freely flowed. The picture collage of past Presidents was awesome and the tribute to Mike was so very, very special to me and will remain in my heart forever. The gift given to me, to accept as a token to past Presidents, is in under the tree and I will open it Christmas Day as my gift from Mike. Life goes on but part of me died too and I know one day we will dance again in Heaven.

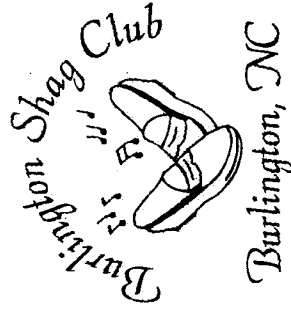
