Minutes from Meeting held February 18, 2005:

Meeting was opened by Sheila Walker.

Current Membership: 312

Angie Sharpe noted that the minutes from the January meeting were published in the February Shag Rag and asked the membership if any changes needed to be made. No changes were indicated, the minutes stand.

Treasure's report was given by Mary Gregory; see Shag Rag for details.

Sheila received a flyer on the Alamance Chamber of Commerce and the current events. She mentioned to the club that if anyone was interested in seeing the flyer they could see her after the meeting.

DJ's for the club have been booked through the month of April and if there are any suggestions for future DJs, give Kent Bradsher the name of the DJ and contact information.

Carol Pettigrew gave an update on membership and stated that at the end of February, any member who has not renewed their membership would be removed from the roster and not receive a Shag Rag. In the place of the Shag Rag, these individuals will receive a post card reminding them to renew their membership.

Update on Sunshine Committee – Sheila mentioned to the club that Fred Hallaman injured his hand in an accident and had surgery. Kent Bradsher is home from the hospital and doing better. Sheila reminded the club to send all Sunshine related items to Judy Lindley and to be sure to include a current address.

Meals on Wheels update – Total attendance was around 600. Silent auction raised \$6747.00 and the amount for the 50/50 was \$573.00. The grand total for entire event before expenses was \$33,721.13. Lawn Buddy tickets sold equaled 315 tickets with a net profit of \$1411.00. It was asked if the membership wanted to do this event for 2006 and there was great discussion on whether or not the club needed to look at other charities. Supporting comments were given for both doing the event again and looking to do a benefit for another group going forward. A motion was made to do the event for Meals on Wheels for 2006 and it was tabled for further investigation and discussion. It was suggested that there be a follow-up meeting for all committee member and that Al Fogleman would be in touch in regards to the time and place for the meeting.

ACSC workshop in Mooresville is February 25-27, 2005 and tickets are limited. Carol Pettigrew mentioned that if anyone was interested she had two for sale.

Bus trip to Eden Area shag club March 12th is being planned by Denise and Chuck Upchurch. Need a total of 27 people to ride to keep the cost to \$15 per person. Cost of bus is approximately \$400 and only 17 people have signed up so far. There is also a \$5 entry fee at the door to get into the party. Also, bus trip to Eno Shag Party for May 1st is being planned, see Chuck or Denise if interested.

No update available for the Float Committee at this time, more information will be available at next business meeting.

BSC Area Shag Club Party – Sheila mentioned that plans need to start being made now. Ronnie Gregory, committee chair, mentioned that it was going to be in the Ramada convention center, the club would sell tickets for cooler similar to lawn buddy and that 300+ people attended the event last year. In the past the president had decided what DJ would play for the area party, a motion was made to continue with how things were handled in the past and the motion was declined with 10 opposing and 7 for. Then a motion was made for the president to take suggestions, it was passed with 17 for and 0 opposing. Sheila asked for suggestions for DJs, the following were proposed by the members:

Motion was made to close nominations and motion was passed. The going rate for DJ at area party is \$250.

By Laws Committee Update: The committee is almost complete with the revision and will bring them to the club for review once completed.

Clay Street After Work – Amy Pendergraph contacted Sheila Walker asking if the club would do a demonstration on June 17th from 8:15 to 8:30. This event conflicts with business meeting night in June, therefore the club will be able to attend.


