Dues: The committee reviewing this policy has had one meeting but is not ready to report back as of yet.

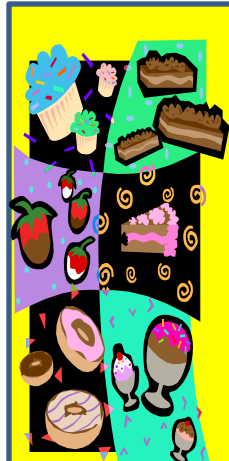
50/50: Mary Gregory won \$49.00.
