5th Annual Shaggin' for Hope

In 2003, Patricia G. Bynum saw a need and began to fill it. She looked past the pain of the cancer diagnosis and saw patients who were also hurting due to struggles to pay their household bills, costs of medications and medical supplies and other basic necessities of life. As she was going through radiation herself, Patricia created a fund to assist those less fortunate patients of the Cancer Center at Alamance Regional Medical Center. Since its beginning, the fund has provided food, gas vouchers, utilities, rent, insurances, taxes, medical and dental care, and more. About a year after she established the fund, Patricia passed away, yet those who remember her still speak of her infectious laugh and compassion for others.

The Patricia Bynum Fund makes it possible for Alamance Regional to minister to patients whose needs transcend the medical care provided. As Coral says, "It's sad but true that some patients are dismissed from their jobs once their short-term disability runs out and they are unable to return." Although they are without an income, their bills still arrive in the mail and their children still need school supplies. For expenses not covered under insurance, the Patricia Bynum Fund may make the difference in a family keeping the roof over their heads and nourishing food in their stomachs.

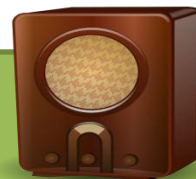

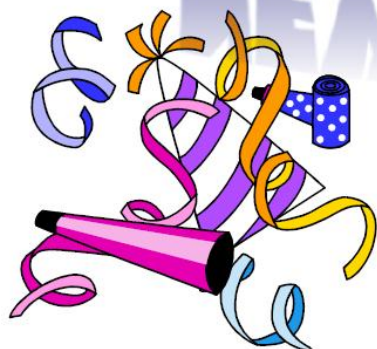

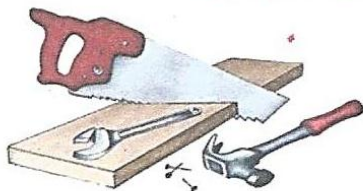
