Christmas Party: Cindy Swiggett, head of the venue search committee, announced that they have looked into several places which varied from \$700.00 - \$2750.00 in costs to rent the venue alone. Some of the sites were too small. Ramada would make us purchase all food and drink from them. Country Club Lanes (CCL) has offered to have us there for free and we can bring our own food in. The committee is recommending that we reserve Country Club Lanes for our event and donate a fee to them for letting us have the party there. Discussion was held and questions were asked about the noise factor (CCL would put all bowlers at the other end of the building to help with this since they can't shut it down for a private party. They will however, close the lounge off for our "after" party.) Dinner would be set up in the pool table area, once it is cleared out. Food would be in the area next to it. 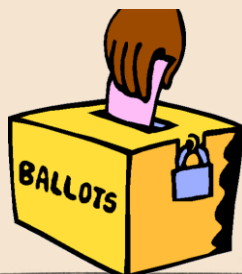

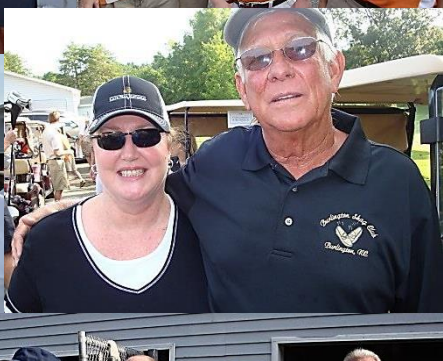
FRIDAY NIGHTS

 - 3) Regular attendance and participation in the Burlington Shag Club and/or ACSC/SOS.

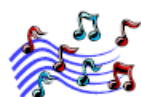

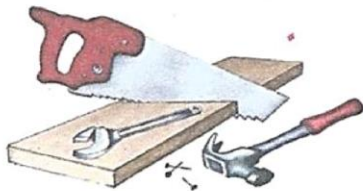
