

We have been getting visitors coming into our club from various locations, so it was brought to my attention recently that maybe we should, as a club, have special lodging rates to offer for out-of-town members and visitors in Burlington. I have been on the phone with Regina at the Best Western Hotel on Huffman Mill Road, since it would probably be the closest to Showtime. At certain times during the year (Elon Homecoming, Elon Parent weekend, etc.) there may not be rooms available, or the special room rate will not apply. Please keep this in mind when calling for a reservation.


