

Joan stated that when she went to the workshop this past weekend, the ACSC officers who came to the MOW event were really impressed with our efforts and how well it went. Joan also let us know that she is still getting some silent auction donated such as a signed UNC basketball from Sylvia Hatchel, various gift cards, etc. On Friday night, March 7<sup>th</sup>, she will set up a table in the back of the lounge area and we will have a mini silent auction for these items. Bring your extra money with you next week!

**Float**---Amy reminded everyone that the parade is April 12 and at this time the streets are torn up and no established parade route is finalized--time will determine the exact route. She also stated that we are on everyone's radar and the SOS chairperson jokingly offered a \$1000.00 bounty to anyone who could beat us.
