#### BSC Business Meeting 6/20/14

Lee called meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Joan welcomed members who were in attendance.

- Joan corrected a note she put into the last newsletter in that she listed Chuck Upchurch as Co-Chairman of the Special Olympics Golf Tournament Benefit. Jesse Justice is actually the Co-Chairman and Joan wanted to be sure that was corrected.
- The Secretary notes were addressed by Evelyn Turner with currently 318 members. Doug Foley made a motion to accept the minutes in the newsletter and Penny Rice seconded that motion. A vote carried to approve the minutes.
- Evelyn also read the birthday list for July.
- The Treasury report was noted by Amy Crawford. A motion to accept the report was made by Doug and seconded by Edith Loy – vote to approve the report carried.
- BSC logo T-shirts A quantity of t-shirts were donated to the club with sale of the shirts to be used for Christmas Cheer. The colors are blue, lime, and pink, and the cost is \$15. Please see Kim Sellars to purchase a shirt.
- The Sunshine report was read by Penny. Joan asked for special thoughts and prayers to support our members going through hard times.
- Edith noted that she had 3 SOS cards left to be sold. Also, she has Fun Monday raffle tickets to sell. These tickets need to be turned in by August 30<sup>th</sup>, so please see her soon to purchase your ticket.
- Joan advised there would be great bands on Main Street for Fun Sunday and Fun Monday. She noted that the sale of Fun Monday raffle tickets helps to pay for the bands.
- Fun Monday Booth Mike Wilson advised that the Board of Directors has discussed whether or not to have a BSC booth at Fun Monday. Could not find anyone who wanted to chair it. The B/D recommended that we not have a booth this year. Evelyn made a motion not to have one and Doug seconded it. A vote carried not to have a Fun Monday booth this year.
- The June Board of Directors meeting was held immediately after the June business meeting. Edith advised the subjects discussed were:
  1) Fun Monday; 2) Cube; 3) SOS script party; 4) member appreciation party; and 5) the yard sale.
- ACSC meeting held at Summer Workshop Joan advised the current ACSC officers were re-elected. The Cammy Awards will be held November 9<sup>th</sup>. You can vote by being a member. Go online to get information.
- Junior SOS being held this weekend. Joan advised the Ellen Taylor Foundation helps fund some of the juniors and also donates shag shoes for them. Members can donate gently used shoes for these juniors.
- Don David, SOS Parade Chairman advised the 2015 parade will be "The Third Beginning of the First Parade". Joan received a copy of the 2014 parade at the ACSC meeting.
- Special Olympics Golf Tournament is being held August 9<sup>th</sup>. Jesse advised everything is coming along real well. We have \$2,500 in sponsors already. Teams need to pre-register with Jesse or Stephen Stearns. Members are asked to bring desserts, and come and help.
- Joan advised that on August 22<sup>nd</sup>, Betty Brown will be the DJ at Showtime for the first time.
- Fall SOS, September 12-21. The OD Arcade has been reserved for a BSC Script Party on the first Saturday. This was discussed by the B/D and was recommended that members only will be given script, which can be used only during a designated time during the Arcade that night. Because there was \$1500 allocated in the Spring for the float and that money was not needed, the Board recommended that \$750 of that be allocated for the script party. Motion was made by Baxter Sellars and seconded by Mike Wilson. Vote carried.

- Winston Salem Shag Club will have their area party on August 23<sup>rd</sup>. You can get information on this from their website.
- The next ACSC meeting will be held during Fall SOS on the last Saturday. Club members can attend this meeting to learn more of the workings of the ACSC and the history of SOS.
- The September business meeting will be moved to Sept 26<sup>th</sup> because of SOS. At this meeting, nominations for 2015 Officers and applicable Board Members will be taken by Lee and Dianne Neese. Also, the Hall of Fame committee names will be determined. Edith Loy will chair the Hall of Fame voting this year.
- Lee Neese announced the proposal of a club cornhole tournament in the back parking lot of Showtime Lounge. Will need at least 10 teams (20 players) and will be a double elimination event. Cost is \$15 per person and there will be a cash prize to the winning team. Teams will be drawn. Play will start at 4:00 p.m. Legality of all play will be governed by "Lee's Rules". A party will be held in the lounge afterwards. A motion was made by Evelyn to hold the tournament and seconded by Lee. Vote carried.
- Yard Sale is scheduled for Saturday, October 4th. Mike advised that the B/D (in their regular meeting) recommended not to have a yard sale this year, but after discussion with Stephen Stearns, learned that Stephen has already made arrangements for a trailer, had flyers printed up, and done some other promotion for it also. That being considered, the B/D now recommends that plans be continued for the yard sale. Proceeds from this will go to our Christmas Cheer fund and any leftover items will be donated to Hospice. Edith made motion to proceed with yard sale and Mike seconded vote carried. Joan will advise when trailer is on the lot at Stearns Ford.
- With reference to nomination of officers and board members, Dianne advised that according to our revised by-laws, if a nominee cannot be at the October business meeting, with a valid reason, to accept the position, the chairman of the committee can accept for them. Nominee should advise chairman in advance of the meeting. Dianne also asked that if you nominate someone for office, please be serious about it because these are very responsible positions. She also reminded everyone that officers and members of the board must attend all business meetings and this should be kept in mind when making nominations.
- Membership Appreciation Party Mike advised that the Board members want to have a membership appreciation party on Saturday, October 25<sup>th</sup>. This will be held at Amanda Point, located on Mike's property south of Burlington. This will be combined with Mike's annual chili party. This will be free to all club members – the only things you need to bring are your own beverages and chairs. The club had already budgeted \$500 for this event. The Board advised guests can attend for a small charge. More details and directions will be advised.
- Bowling Tournament Evelyn asked the Board to consider a Fall Bowling Tournament, perhaps the first or second Saturday in November.
- Fun Golf Tournament 2015 Jesse said we need to book early. May and June 2015 are already booked at Indian Valley Golf Course. The date of April 4<sup>th</sup> is available, so Jesse asked the Board to consider approval of this tournament.
- Amy noted a few changes in the expenditures.
- ACSC Summer Workshop 2016 the shag club from Columbia, SC placed a bid for this and won it.

The 50/50 amount was \$39 and was won by Baxter.

Meeting adjourned at 8:18.
