Sidewalk Paver in NMB: Joan presented the idea of the club purchasing a sidewalk paver that would be placed in front of the O.D. Arcade, our home away from home. For \$200.00, we can get a small paver with 4 lines on it. We discussed this option and also getting a larger paver (12" X12" or 16" X 16") and including our logo if that option is available.
