LEARN CPR

On June 25th, Bud Catoe met with a few BSC members at Showtime Lounge to instruct on our AED defibrillator. Bud briefly mentioned the importance of proper CPR during such an emergency, but did not do any CPR instruction since the class takes 2+ hours of training. He is willing to teach a CPR class if there is enough interest from membership. We have **not** set a date or time – we first need to know how many members are interested.

This training is being offered free of charge and what you will learn is how to save a life. A heart attack may not necessarily happen in our lounge or at one of our events, it may be in your own home – or while walking down the street – you might be driving in your car – you could be on a golf course. Heart attacks do not pick or choose when and where. What you learn in this class could save the life of your spouse, your child or another family member, or a dear friend. That window of opportunity is a quick five minutes and help may not be just around the corner

Please contact Joan Kimbro as soon as possible – she will contact Bud and determine what date and time would be the most suitable for those wanting to attend. 
