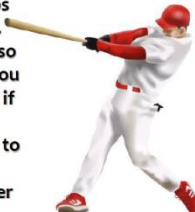
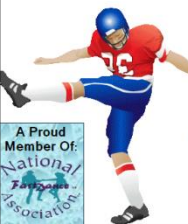

This PayPal account will handle only ticket sales, donations and silent auction charges. Mary Gregory has agreed to handle the back end for our website.
