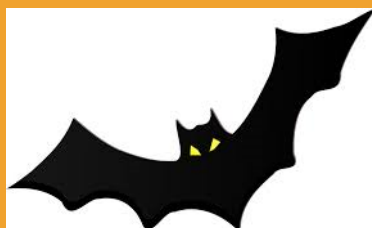

When someone asks me about the Burlington Shag Club I let them know that they are some of the most hard working and community minded folks in Alamance County. I have been working for Special Olympics Alamance County (SOAC) for the last 5 years and one of the things I look forward to every year is helping with the annual Shag Club Golf Tournament. Over the past 22 years that the Shag Club has raised close to \$200,000 for Special Olympics Alamance County and each year provides around 20% of the money used by our local program, more than any other group in SOAC history. It allows us to purchase uniforms, equipment, meals, and travel for our athletes. Our athletes never pay a penny to participate in any of the sports we offer thanks to groups like the BSC. During the year we run eight sports for our athletes. We offer statewide competition in basketball, cycling, bocce, bowling, golf, flag football, equestrian, and alpine skiing. We also have four local events for the athletes in the school system and at group homes. We have local tournaments in bocce, basketball, bowling and our Spring Games at Elon University where we have over 400 athletes and 1500 volunteers, one of the biggest volunteer opportunities in Alamance County. With all this going on, it is awesome that the great folks from the Shag Club are willing to spend their precious time to make sure all these sports have everything they need to take place. Thank you BSC for all your hard work and for everything you do for the community!
