Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Kurt Lankford.

Jack Oakley welcomed everyone to the February meeting.

Secretary's Report: Lorna Shively (filling in for Jan Burwell) stated that we currently have 221 members. She also announced that Jan has the tickets for the Fall SOS raffle for condo at Ashworth--\$10.00 each. A motion was made by Janice McSherry to accept the January minutes and Steve Williamson seconded. All approved.

Birthdays: Lorna recognized the February birthdays.

Treasurer's Report: Amy Crawford reviewed the YTD balances for the club's banking account and the special fundraiser account. Questions and answers were presented. Allen Duvall made a motion to accept the report and Janice McSherry seconded. All approved.

Board of Directors: Lucy Duvall stated that there was a meeting of the Board on 2/6/17 and on 2/16/17. The Board is reviewing the club's tax status, banking options and fund raising options. The board also reviewed the Valentine's Dance and future handling of it by the club. Lorna Shively made a motion to accept this report and Rick Burnam seconded. All approved.

SOS Card: Per Edith Loy, she still has plenty to sell.

Membership Reup Party: Edith stated that we had a great event and that Showtime provided the meal for free and 106 members ate.

Reunion groups and Friday nights: Jack stated that the Board has been reviewing guidelines to make things less problematic when a reunion or other group comes into the lounge during one of our Friday dance nights. They are suggesting that we be given 3 month's-notice (when able), that we ask for a donation for the DJ since the club is currently paying for it in full and also that we make sure they know not to gather on the dance floor or take drinks out there. Spills can be dangerous when dancing. He will present this info to Tony to decide if this is acceptable.

Valentines Party Benefit 2017: Jack reported that he is pleased with the money that we raised and the money that is being given to Hospice, which is \$5000.00. The BOD recommended pooling all funds raised (after expenses paid) and dividing out the proceeds by %. The club, Coastline Band and Hospice received portions of the proceeds with Hospice getting the most and the club the lesser amount.

Steppin' Out shag club: March 11th is their Mardi Gras event in Reidsville, NC. Please plan to attend.

Bank changes: Steve Williamson stated that they have been reviewing our banking accounts and options and have elected to move the accounts from Suntrust Bank to Truliant FCU to take advantage of no fees, free checks and better interest. Also, open on Saturdays. They have been reviewing this for months and will make the change once the Valentine's Fundraiser monies have been finalized.

Valentine's Party Benefit for 2018?: Jack asked the members if they want to explore holding the Valentine's Benefit for 2018. It will be on February 10, 2018. Steve Williamson made a motion to do this and Amy Crawford seconded. All approved.

50/50 tickets: Event chairpersons should make sure that ALL 50/50 tickets are the same color.

50/50 drawing: Tammy McDole won the 50/50.

Called Meeting for BSC 2/24/17

Kurt Lankford called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

A Quorum was declared.

Jack opened the meeting, welcoming everyone and thanking them for coming.

Per Jack, the reason for this meeting is that we need to make a decision about reserving Ramada for next year's Valentine's Dance Benefit and how we want to proceed. We previously approved exploring our options regarding this event.

We need to ensure that we have the Ramada reserved for the 2/10/18 date. Up until this time, the club was not financially able to sponsor the event on our own. That was the reason that we set up the "fundraising" account. We have been able to grow the account so that we could sponsor this on our own. We now have enough of a balance in that account to do so. Multiple sites were reviewed and the Ramada was still the best offer, financially.

The 3 options that we have at this time are:

- 1. BSC to sponsor the event along with contracting with a band.
- 2. Continue with Jim Quick and Coastline to remain "sponsor" which they are willing to do. There is no contract with them and they would have final say on the distribution of proceeds.
- 3. Have no benefit at all.

Steve Williamson made a motion to have the paper ballot for the above options. Janice McSherry seconded. All approved the motion. Ballots were passed out and returned for counting. There were a total of 32 ballots cast, with 27 voting for BSC to sponsor the event (option 1). We will be placing a deposit of \$200.00 with Ramada to reserve the date/room.

As the sponsors of this event, we need to select a band. Due to time constraints with some of these bands and early bookings, we need to make a decision immediately. One of the bands under consideration needs an answer by tomorrow; otherwise, they will not hold the 2/10/18 date open for us. Several bands have been contacted along with getting a copy of their contracts and information on costs and deposits required. The bands up for consideration are: The Embers, Jim Quick and Coastline, Blackwater Rhythm and Blues (who cannot guarantee their lead singer for that date) and The Band of Oz. The prices for the bands range from \$3250.00 - \$4500.00, with deposits from \$0.00 - \$750.00.

Rick Burnham made a motion to contract with the Band of Oz and Kurt Lankford seconded. A vote was taken and the majority voted to contract with The Band of Oz to play at our 2018 event so the motion carried.
