Working at Honda Power Equipment in the HR Dept, Kim and her coworkers work to continually improve associate development. Because of her job, Kim has traveled all across North America and to Europe, Asia, and South America. Hopefully Africa and Australia are in the near future.

After presenting Butch with shag lessons one year for Christmas, Kim says the rest is history. They have connected with old friends and made new ones who are a big part of their lives now. Kim noted that they have met so many wonderful people and had so much fun in connection with the Burlington Shag Club.

Kim's comments: "I realize life is fragile so I like to have fun. I find humor in everything thanks to my father and I love to have fun and laugh. I would like to think the thing someone would say about me is that 'she hugged me like she meant it'. Because I do."


Valentine's Benefit - Silent Auction Bake Sale



we can begin bowling at 6:30 pm. I promise you that you will have another GOOD TIME with this club!!!


