CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) and You

How can I protect myself and my family?

The following is recommended by the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services:

Wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds at a time. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.

Avoid close contact with people who are ill.

Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze.

Do not reuse tissue after coughing, sneezing or blowing your nose.

Clean and disinfect surfaces that are frequently touched.





Should you see a doctor?

The <u>CDC</u> says: If you think you have been exposed to COVID-19 and develop a fever and symptoms of respiratory illness, such as cough or difficulty breathing, call your healthcare provider immediately.

Home-made sanitizers, all share the same basic formula. Here are the ingredients: 1/3 cup of aloe vera gel 2/3 cup of 99% isopropyl alcohol (rubbing alcohol) Mixing bowl A spoon or whisk A clean, empty container, like a plastic travel bottle or a pump bottle. Simply stir the aloe vera gel and alcohol until they are well blended and then pour the mixture into the bottle.



Optional: Add a few drops of your favorite essential oil while mixing. It won't have any effect on the potency of your concoction, but it might make it smell nicer.
