

Old Business:

Bylaw Committee (Jack Oakley) Jack reported that he had been appointed chair of the bylaw committee by the board. He requested members to contact him with any concerns about bylaws for the committee to review. The first meeting will be Tuesday Sept 14th at 6pm.

2021 SOS Fall Migration Script Party (Kim Sellars) The script party is scheduled for Thursday Sept 23rd 6-8pm at the OD Arcade. Five-dollar scripts will be given to BSC club members to toward drinks, food, or merchandise only during the designated time of 6-8pm. The scripts are not good after 8pm.

2021 Christmas Saturday Dec 4th (Darlene Oakley chair). The Christmas party committee has met and working on plans for the party at Burlington Shrine Club. Tickets are on sale at Friday Shag nights. Tickets must be purchased in advance. Deadline for purchase is November 24th. Tickets are \$25 for members, \$35 for non-members. AED (heart defibrillator) (Kim Sellars) The AED cabinet, wall sign, and new pads have been purchased by Darlene Oakley and installed by Jack. Darlene has created a monthly log sheet to document battery function and pad expiration. Kim contacted Bud Catoe to schedule CPR and AED training for a Saturday. Kim passed around a sign up.

Christmas Cheer (Kim Sellars) Kim reported she had taken a load of items that had been placed in the BSC collection buckets on Friday Nights to Betty Hall, Christmas Cheer Director. Kim stated that Christmas Cheer has no government funding, and that 100 percent of donations go to the community. Last year they helped 510 families, 1311 children and 150 elderlies. In addition to items listed in the BSC newsletter, Christmas Cheer needs volunteers to deliver items. Kim passed around a sheet for volunteers.

Boston Butt Fundraiser (Kim Sellars) Kim asked if the club is interested in having a Boston Butt sale Saturday November 19th to benefit the club general fund. It is anticipated that club membership will be down and revenue from January reup may be lower. Jack made a motion to hold a Boston Butt fundraiser for the club general fund on November 19th. 
All BSC members are encouraged to come out and support the club by participating in club meetings!



IV. ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE

- E. Duties of the club officers:
 - 2. Vice-President

b. To chair the Ways and Means committee. Tenure shall not exceed the term of the current President. The committee, chairperson, or any committee member can be removed by the current Board of Directors.

b. To assist the President and other officers in other duties as requested.

VI. VOTING

- A. A properly deemed voting body would constitute a minimum of five percent (5%) of the total club current membership, plus a minimum of three officers, at any club meeting.
- A. A properly deemed voting body would constitute a minimum of ten percent (10%) of the total club current membership, plus a minimum of three officers, at any club meeting.
- B. All votes will be decided by a majority of the members present.
- C. A motion will not be voted on until the next month's business meeting if it includes expenditure not in the approved annual budget and greater than \$500.
- D. In respect to the election of officers, newly-elected officers shall have received a majority of the votes cast for each office.
- E. A member must have joined the club prior to August 1st in order to be eligible to cast a vote in the election of officers in November.
- F. Members must be in attendance at the November business meeting in order to vote.

- 4. To see that tickets, if used for said event, are available and distributed to the club members for sale. This includes tracking of the ticket numbers, if required. Club members will volunteer to sell tickets.
- 5. To disperse complimentary tickets awarded to Hall of Fame members and Past Presidents for the following special functions: Annual Christmas Party and Area Shag Club Party.
- 6. To be responsible for choosing a DJ for the specific event.
