Parade float cookout is scheduled for Saturday, April 9th, all members are welcome to celebrate the fellowship and hard work of the club! Look for more details to come!!

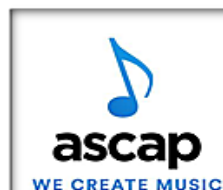
