## SOS (Society of Stranders)

#### What is it and what's it all about?



In the early 1980's a bunch of lifeguards and beach bums, led by Swink Laughter made their annual ritual trip to N. Myrtle Beach to dance and show off their creative dance moves to party and have a good time with their friends. Shag music was a form of Rhythm

and Blues and over the years and now it is called Carolina Beach Music. In the formative days of SOS, there was hardly any organization or structure, just people coming to the beach for a good time. After just a few short years, it had grown so much, that it was becoming too much for a few people to manage. In 1989, Swink offered to sell it to the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs. ACSC bought SOS at this time. The 3 men and others that was instrumental in buying SOS was Dr. Phil Sawyer, Ron Whisenant, and Ken Hudspeth.

SOS is a "for Profit" of ACSC and ACSC is Non-Profit. SOS raises money through the sale of SOS Cards to fund such things as the Parade, Hall of Fame Foundation, support of Fun Monday, support of Jr. Shaggers, Carefree Times, Website, Facebook, and most importantly the dance floor space so that we all can enjoy the Shag dancing. By purchasing SOS, it brought structure and organization to SOS. It continued to grow through the years. It would be impossible for us to have SOS, if it wasn't for your support in buying the SOS Cards which makes you a member of the ACSC, which we all should be proud of. The SOS Cards is the backbone of SOS. When you buy this card, it helps us further the music, dance and lifestyle of SOS and gives you free admission to all our partner beach clubs for (2) 10-day events and (1) 4-day event.

SOS through its partnership with our SOS Clubs, City of N. Myrtle Beach, Jr. Shaggers, DJs, Dance Instructors, and ACSC Clubs keeps SOS Strong and keeps the party alive.

I know you are proud of all the accomplishments and all the contributions that Burlington Shag Club, SOS, and ACSC has accomplished together. There are also many more stories to tell about SOS, but I will leave that for another Burlington Shag Club newsletter.


